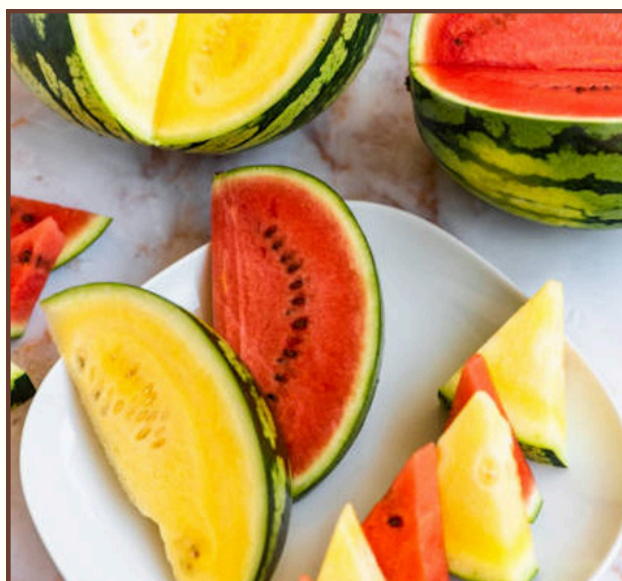
GUAVA

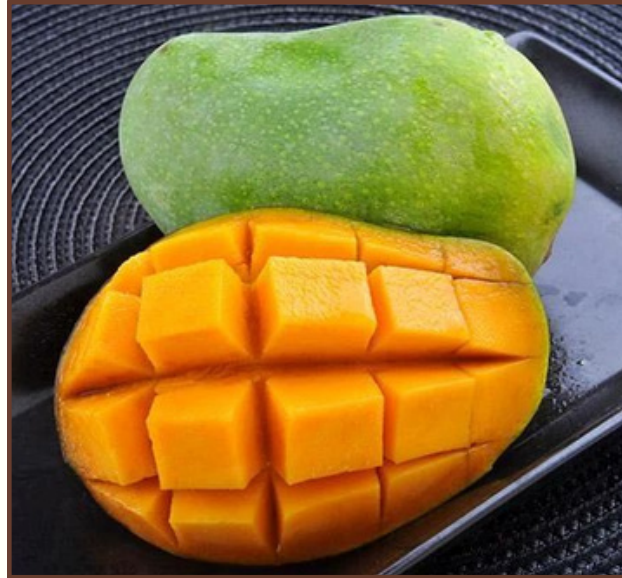
