Our Commitment to Families

Brabeion Academy uses Title I funds to establish structured, meaningful opportunities for parents and family members to stay connected and involved.

- **Open Planning & Decision Making:** We actively involve parents in the organized, ongoing planning, review, and improvement of school programs, policies, and our schoolwide program plan.
- **Annual Informational Meeting:** Every year, we host a convenient meeting for all parents to explain our school programs, detail the right of parents to be involved, and answer any policy questions.
- **Flexible Accommodations:** We offer meetings at varied times. When feasible, Title I funds may be used to assist with transportation, child care, or home visits to make sure you can participate.
- **Clear & Accessible Communication:** All information regarding programs, meetings, and student academic progress is distributed in an understandable format and—to the extent practicable—in a language you speak.

The School-Parent Compact

As part of our commitment, our school community collaboratively designs a **School-Parent Compact**. This agreement outlines how students, parents, and school staff share the daily responsibility for high academic achievement.

The School's Responsibility

Our teachers and administration promise to:

- Provide a high-quality, supportive, and effective learning environment so your child can meet state academic standards.
- Deliver frequent progress reports and offer continuous, two-way communication.
- Host annual parent-teacher conferences to specifically review student achievements and goals.
- Ensure reasonable access to staff, opportunities to volunteer, and windows to observe classroom activities.

The Parent's Responsibility

We invite parents to take an active, daily role by:

- Communicating regularly with school staff and staying aware of rules and regulations.
- Ensuring your child arrives at school prepared, healthy, and ready to learn each day.
- Reinforcing skills and concepts learned at school through home support and reading regularly.
- Taking advantage of volunteering windows, training sessions, and school activities.

The Student's Responsibility

Students are encouraged to take ownership of their learning by:

- Cooperating politely with school personnel and taking responsibility for their own behavior.
- Completing all home assignments thoroughly and on time.
- Participating to the absolute best of their ability in every class.
- Reading independently or with family members outside of school hours.
- Reaching out to teachers, staff, or family when they need academic or emotional help.

Family Empowerment & Resources

To help you feel fully equipped to advocate for your child, Brabeion Academy provides targeted support:

- **Academic Monitoring Tools:** We offer assistance and training to help you understand state academic standards, look at local assessments, and monitor your child's continuous progress.
- **Skill-Building Workshops / Home Learning Support:** Families can access materials and training focused on home literacy and technology usage.
- **Literacy Support:** In instances where families face literacy barriers the academy coordinates accessible family literacy programs.
- **Parent Advisory Board:** We invite parents to join our Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) to regularly review, adapt, and give feedback on how the school serves our community.
- **Information request:** parents may request information from the Chief Instruction & Assessment Officer regarding:
 - Professional qualifications of classroom teachers.
 - Mandated assessment and opt out policy.
