

Flight Club Rules:

Entry fee to be determined by organizer.

All fees collected shall be submitted to Rob or Tee Soik with Results including flight sheets

All fees will be used to pay for entry into ADO Regional Qualifier (currently \$75.00 each)

Transportation, lodging, food and other expenses will be the participants responsibility.

Round robin format will be used with 8 or less players

for more than 8 players Modified Round Robin (MRR) format will be used.

Round Robin format will be 3 legs everyone plays everyone.

MRR format will split players into groups of 4 or more with an even number of groups (2, 4, or 8) with the top half advancing to a single elimination bracket (2 out of 3) seeded by wins from the group play.

If we have enough women players (4 or more), they will have their own group and points. Those funds will be applied to a women's entry into the regional qualifier. (All womens funds will be documented with priority towards a womens entry.)

There are four ADO National Finals in 2026

501 National Championship – January 16th (Las Vegas Open)

Masters Finals – March 27th (Virginia Beach Classic)

Cricket National Championship – July 10th (Charlotte Open)

US Team Finals – September 18th (Witch City Open)

We are currently focused on sending players to a qualifier, or holding a qualifier in Casper for the Cricket National Championships. (Feb to June) the last cricket qualifier in our region is tentatively scheduled for June 13th.

Regional Qualifiers are \$75 for each player, Round Robin or MRR format with an Open group and a Womens group.

For every 10 players, one player will have the entry fee and flight paid for by the ADO to attend the National Final. (In the past they did include \$100 for food and other expenses.* I will verify if this is current.)
