

Ordinance No. 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE OF ELSINBORO TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE KEEPING OF BACKYARD CHICKENS IN
RESIDENTIAL ZONES

WHEREAS, the governing body of Elsinboro Township recognizes the growing interest among residents in keeping backyard chickens for personal use, including egg production and educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the governing body seeks to permit the keeping of backyard chickens in a manner consistent with the public health, safety, welfare, and in keeping with established best practices; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of this ordinance to allow residents to keep egg-laying hens under regulated conditions that minimize nuisance, ensure animal welfare, and preserve neighborhood quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Elsinboro Township, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, that the Revised Ordinances of Elsinboro Township are hereby supplemented to add a new Article "Keeping of Backyard Chickens" as follows:
