ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 1999 E-ONE PUMPER FIRE TRUCK
OWNED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF ELSINBORO AND NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE TO
THE TOWNSHIP OF ELSINBORO**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. §40A:12-13(b)(1) of the Local Lands and Buildings Law, any municipality may sell personal property at private sale by ordinance to any political subdivision, agency, department, commission, board or body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Elsinboro was the recipient of a 1999 E-One pumper fire truck (the "Property") from the City of Salem, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salem was in discussions with the Elsinboro Fire Company to sell the Property to the fire company;

WHEREAS, the City of Salem and the Elsinboro Fire Company agreed that the 1999 E-One pumper requires an estimated \$10,000.00 to \$15,000.00 in maintenance costs, which exceeds its value of less than \$5,000.00, in light of which the Elsinboro Fire Company agreed to purchase the Property for the sum of \$1.00 and the City of Salem agreed to sell the Property for the sum of \$1.00;

WHEREAS, the City of Salem adopted an Ordinance, 2025-01 approving the sale and inadvertently reciting that the sale was made to the Township of Elsinboro. The City of Salem declined to amend its ordinance and the Township of Elsinboro accepted the Property with the intention of transferring it to the Elsinboro Fire Company

WHEREAS on May 6, 2025, the Township of Elsinboro accepted the Property;

WHEREAS, the Township of Elsinboro has determined that the Property is not needed for public use in the Township and therefore may be conveyed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(1); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of Elsinboro Township County of Salem, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Township of Elsinboro hereby determines that the Property identified below in not needed for public use and therefore may be conveyed by private sale pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(1).

Property Identification 1999 E-One pumper fire truck Price \$1.00

3. A list of the property authorized to be sold herein, together with the minimum prices set forth herein, shall be posted on the bulletin board or other conspicuous place in the building in which the Governing Body holds its regular meetings and advertisement thereof made in a newspaper circulating in the Township in which the real property is situated, within five (5) days following the enactment of this Ordinance. Offers for any and all property so listed may thereafter be made to the Governing Body or its designee for a period of twenty (20) days following the advertisement herein required, at not less than said minimum prices set forth herein, by any prospective purchaser or other authorized representative. In any such case, the Governing Body may reconsider this Ordinance, not later than thirty (30) days after its enactment, and advertise the Property in question for public sale pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(a).

4. In the event that the sale of the property is completed as a private sale, the Township shall file with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, sworn affidavits verifying the publication of advertisements as required by N.J. S.A. 40A:12-13.

5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

7. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after adoption, provided that the Ordinance is not reconsidered by the Governing Body pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.
