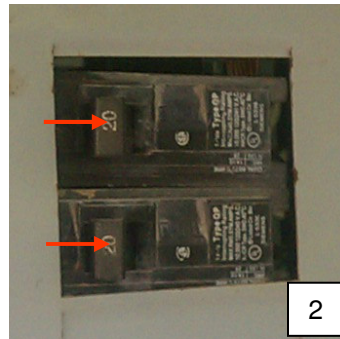


Grant's Mountain - Instruction to open gate manually - loss of power



1 – Open power panel, located inside the gate on the right side. You will have to lift the tab on the bottom of the panel (pictured in red circle) to get the door to lift open.

2 – Turn off both breakers to insure power does not come back on during this operation, by pushing them in the right direction.



3 – Walk over to slide gate and look for the Master Lock box located about mid way up the gate.

4 – Roll the numbers to read 1911 and then push down on the black lever, located to the left of the numbers.

5 – With the tab pushed down, pull the little black handle located below the numbers to pull the key box open. Remove the key.



6 – Insert the key into the clutch lock override switch, pictured with a red square around it. This is located on the bottom side of the gate control box.

7 – Turn the key clock-wise to disengage the clutch lock.

8 – Once the clutch is unlocked, push the slide gate open. This will take a pretty good bit of force to get the gate completely open.

9 – Once gate is open, perform operations in reverse from 8 to 1. Turn Clutch lock in CCW direction. Remove key and put it back inside lock box. Close lockbox and scramble numbers. Flip breakers back on (to the left) and close power cabinet lid. This will insure the gate works properly when power has been restored.
