MAJOR LOCAL ISSUES TO CONSIDER

THE FOLLOWING ARE KEY ISSUES WE SHOULD ALL BE PAYING ATTENTION TO:

I-77 HIGHWAY

THE I-77 SOUTH EXPRESS LANES PROJECT IS MOVING FORWARD, ADDING TOLL LANES BETWEEN UPTOWN CHARLOTTE AND THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE LINE. THE LONG-TERM CONTRACT IS MANAGED BY A PRIVATE DEVELOPER WHO INTENDS TO USE DYNAMIC TOLL PRICING FOR THE LANES – CHANGING BASED ON TRAFFIC LEVELS. SOME VEHICLES LIKE CARPOOLERS, EMERGENCY SERVICES, AND TRANSIT CAN USE THE LANES FOR FREE. THE STATE RETAINS THE RIGHT TO EXPAND HIGHWAY CAPACITY LATER, BUT MUST COMPENSATE THE DEVELOPER IF THAT EXPANSION COMPETES WITH TOLL REVENUE. SUPPORTERS CLAIM IT WILL EASE CONGESTION, WHILE CRITICS SAY IT PRIORITIZES PRIVATE PROFIT OVER PUBLIC INTEREST.

- FASTER OPTION DURING PEAK TRAFFIC
- FREE FOR CARPOOLERS, TRANSIT, & EMERGENCY VEHICLES
- REAL-TIME TRAFFIC UPDATES
- DISCOUNTS FOR LOW-INCOME DRIVERS
- AIMS TO REDUCE CONGESTION WITH TOLLS

CONS

- PRIVATELY-OPERATED FOR PROFIT
- TOLL RATES RISE YEARLY
- MORE LANES CAN MEAN MORE TRAFFIC
- IMPACTS NEARBY NEIGHBORHOODS
- STATE MUST PAY TO BUILD FREE ALTERNATIVES
- LONG-TERM PRIVATE DEAL LIMITS PUBLIC CONTROL
- PUBLIC TAXED TWICE

COP CITY

A \$100+ MILLION PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING FACILITY IS PLANNED NEXT TO CPCC'S LEVINE CAMPUS IN MATTHEWS, AIMED AT POLICE, FIRE, AND EMS TRAINING. FUNDED THROUGH COUNTY RESOURCES AND PARTNERSHIPS, THE PROJECT INCLUDES A MAJOR LAND DONATION —BUT MUCH OF THE DECISION-MAKING HAPPENED WITH LIMITED PUBLIC INPUT. CRITICS SAY THE PROCESS LACKED TRANSPARENCY AND MAY HAVE VIOLATED OPEN MEETING LAWS. WHILE SUPPORTERS CITE IMPROVED SAFETY AND TRAINING, OPPONENTS ARGUE IT PRIORITIZES POLICE INFRASTRUCTURE OVER BROADER COMMUNITY NEEDS.

PROS

- SPACE FOR POLICE, FIRE, & EMS TRAINING
- UPDATED FACILITIES AND WEAPONRY
- IMPROVE REGIONAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE
- PROMOTES SHARED USE ACROSS AGENCIES
- AIMS TO ENHANCE OFFICER READINESS

CONS

- PLANNING LACKED PUBLIC TRANSPARENCY
- PRIORITIZES POLICING OVER OTHER NEEDS
- MINIMAL INPUT FROM RESIDENTS BEFORE APPROVAL
- CONCERNS ABOUT MILITARIZED POLICING
- COMMUNITY IMPACT NOT FULLY EVALUATED
- FINANCIAL RESOURCES DIVERTED FROM MORE COMMUNITY RESPONDER JOBS
