There is no right or wrong way to colour a dragon.


Let your imagination lead the way.

What colour is the red dragon in your picture?


How do you think the little king feels when the dragon escapes?


Does the ice dragon seem scary or gentle at first?


What makes the fiery dragon powerful?


What kinds of questions does the boy like to ask?

Look back through the book and choose the dragon you liked the most.


Which dragon did you choose?
