04_ Background of the Event



Amidst an international context marked by rapid transformations and growing challenges affecting issues of justice, human rights, and solidarity among peoples, the International Solidarity Forum with the Sahrawi People is being organized, concurrently with the Fifth Conference of the Students' Union of Saguia el-Hamra and Rio de Oro, during the period from August 5 to 8, 2026, as an international platform for dialogue, exchange, and joint coordination.

This international event will bring together civil society organizations, bodies, and institutions, as well as political, human rights, and humanitarian entities from around the world, with the aim of strengthening international solidarity, exchanging experiences and perspectives on issues of common interest from political, legal, humanitarian, and media dimensions, in addition to building more effective cooperation and partnership bridges between international actors.

This space aspires to form a collective platform to enhance joint action, consolidate the values of freedom, justice, peace, and the right of peoples to self-determination, based on the belief in the importance of international solidarity as a tool for positive change and building a more equitable future.

06_ Nature of Activities

The program includes a mix of political, academic, dialogical, and cultural activities, designed to enhance exchange and interaction among participants and create a space for dialogue and international solidarity. Activities include:



Opening and Official Sessions: Including opening ceremonies, official speeches by participating delegations and organizations, and presentation of reports and political and organizational outcomes of the event



Lectures and Thematic Seminars: Addressing issues of common interest from political, legal, humanitarian, and developmental perspectives, including the role of youth and students, African and international issues, water and development, and civil and solidarity action



Workshops and Interactive Meetings: Aimed at exchanging experiences and fostering discussion among participants on political participation, social justice, media, and human rights



Field Visits to Sahrawi National Institutions: Enabling participants to directly observe the reality of Sahrawi refugees, the experience of national institutions, and community organization mechanisms



Official and Institutional Meetings: With representatives of Sahrawi state institutions to enhance dialogue, communication, and exchange of views



Cultural and Recreational Activities: Including artistic evenings, tourist visits, and interactive programs aimed at cultural exchange and strengthening bonds between participating delegations



Closing Session and Adoption of Outcomes: Dedicated to evaluating the event's proceedings, adopting recommendations, and enhancing future coordination and international cooperation mechanisms
