Purpose:

To strengthen coaching excellence and athlete development across the Panamerican region by providing educational resources, training opportunities, and technical guidance to coaches at all levels.

Key Duties & Responsibilities:

- **Curriculum Development:** Design and maintain standardized coaching curricula tailored to all levels (grassroots to elite), aligned with World Boxing standards and responsive to regional needs.
- **Educational Material Creation:** Develop coaching manuals, guides, and training resources in both English and Spanish to ensure accessibility across the continent.
- **Coach Certification & Licensing:** Support the delivery of coaching certification and licensing programs, and coordinate with National Federations to ensure consistency and recognition across the region.
- **Support for National Federations:**
 - Assist NFs in organizing national-level training seminars and workshops.
 - Respond to requests for educational support and guidance to improve national coaching structures.
- **Seminar Coordination & Delivery:**
 - Coordinate and oversee delivery of coaching seminars and webinars throughout the year.
 - Maintain a calendar of regional educational events and ensure alignment with the competition calendar.
- **Educator Development:** Identify and train a pool of qualified coach educators and instructors to deliver seminars and courses effectively across member countries.
- **Best Practice Sharing:** Facilitate knowledge exchange and technical collaboration among coaches through digital platforms, forums, and in-person events.
- **Technical Input:** Advise on the development and refinement of athlete training frameworks, talent identification, and long-term athlete development models.



- Promotion of Ethical Coaching: Integrate principles of athlete safeguarding, anti-doping awareness, mental health, and ethical coaching conduct into all educational offerings.
