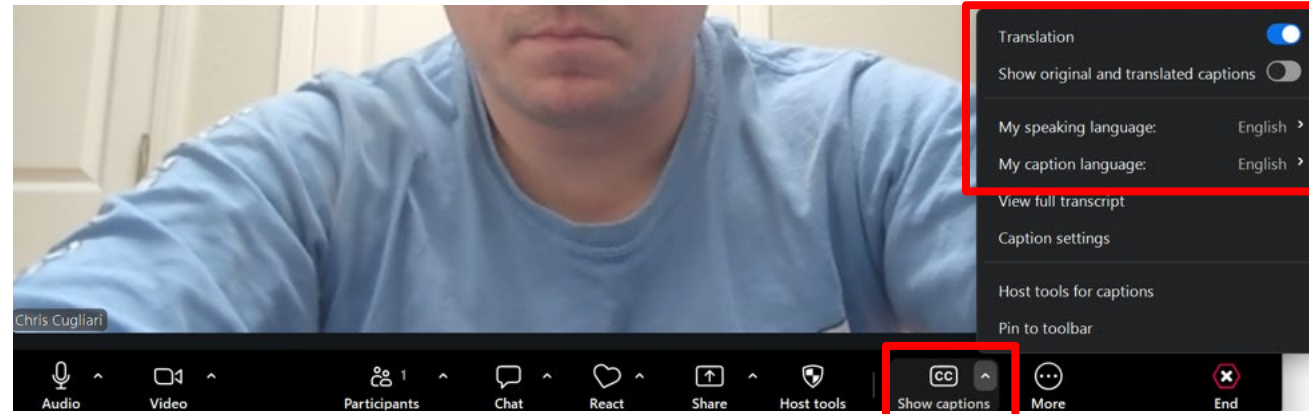


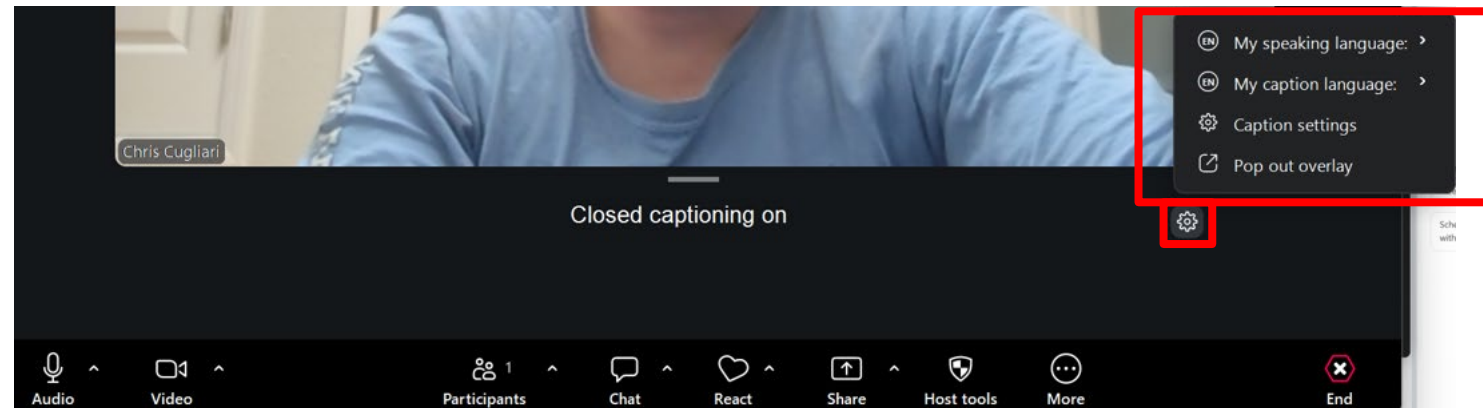

Multi-Sport Games (PBC)

- Central American & Caribbean Games (Centro Caribe Sport) – **31 July – 7 August**: Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic
- South American Games (ODESUR) – **12-18 September**: Rafaela, Argentina
- Youth Bolivarian Games (ODEBO) – **18-29 November**: Caracas, Venezuela
- Registration managed by NOC's with organizing committees of the games

Panamerican Elite Continental Championships – 17-25 October: Puebla, Mexico

- Finalizing competition manual – to distribute in next 2 weeks
- Registration through Xempower
- 2027 Pan Am Games Qualifier and Papp Cup invitations at stake

Papp Cup – 13-14 November Budapest, Hungary

- Prepare accordingly, based on results of Continental Championships
- As LOC (Hungary Boxing Association) is covering costs of airfare and accommodations, immediate confirmation will be required for arrangements

Reminder – Sport Entry Check Requirements:

1. Passport
2. Signed Forms (Code of Conduct, Conditions of Participation, Declaration of non-Pregnancy)
3. Record Book
4. SRY / sex test result
5. Medical Certificate signed/stamped by team physician within past 3 months
6. Red & Blue uniform

18 November	PBC Delegation Arrival
19 November	Non-PBC Delegation Arrival Morning – PBC Pre-Meeting Afternoon – PBC Congress Evening – World Boxing dinner
20 November	World Boxing Pre-Meeting & Congress

- Only FULL MEMBERS (currently 28 PBC) in GOOD STANDING possess right to vote and nominate candidates
 - Article 6.8.iii of PBC Statutes – Full Members obligated to pay dues on time to remain in good standing! **Must have 2025 World Boxing dues paid by August 21 to participate.**
- World Boxing Election – 2 Vice President, 2 Executive Board Seats, and 3 Committee Chairs up for election
 - PBC currently holds 1 of these Executive Board Seats (Marcos) and Chair of Medical & Anti-Doping Committee (Dr. Armando Sanchez)
 - More information / discussion as Congress approaches
- PBC Election – President, 1 VP, 2 Executive Board Seats up for election (1 male, 1 female) – 4 seats total
 - Candidate eligibility determined by independent vetting panel of 3 persons to be finalized by August 11
 - Governance Chamber of Judicial Committee drafted Election Rules to supplement Statutes with additional detail – available on website; REGIONAL AND GENDER RULES WILL APPLY
 - Next election – 2028 (1 VP, 2 Executive Board Seats)

Nov 18 – PBC

Aug 11 – Formal Call to Congress sent – nominations now open; Vetting Panel officially appointed

Aug 21 – Final list of voting Members distributed – deadline to pay 2025 World Boxing dues

Sep 20 – Deadline to submit candidate nomination materials to chris@panamericanboxing.org

Oct 20 – Final, vetted candidate list published; deadline to submit delegate information (3 total if both genders represented, 1 voting)

Nov 19 – PBC Pre-Meeting & Congress

- Candidates must submit the following to chris@panamericanboxing.org between 11 Aug – 20 Sep:
 - Candidate nomination form (on website, will be emailed)
 - CV – highlighting boxing experience
 - Proof of Nationality / Residency – passport copy or legal residency document
 - Completed Code of Conduct and Conflict of Interest forms



R&J Continental Pathway

R&J Rules Seminars

- Overseen by PBC R&J Commission
- Can involve lecture & in-person evaluation
- While 'certificate' is provided, does NOT certify officials to work Continental or International events
 - Helps prepare candidates for World Boxing Evaluation
- Requests sent to officials@panamericanboxing.org

World Boxing Certification

- R&J Evaluation course for Continental Certification run by World Boxing R&J Evaluators
 - Lecture and in-person evaluation
 - 25 candidates per course
- If approved, candidates work Continental Events and are promoted to / demoted from Intercontinental and International levels based on performance
- PBC will have ONE opportunity to host a Continental R&J Evaluation Course in 2026. Qualifications include:
 - Evaluation must have 150+ bouts as part of National or Multi-National tournament
 - \$12,000 USD cost – may be allocated out at \$500 USD per candidate
 - Host receives 5 quota – other Federations may receive 1 or 2 (if 1 female) quota; incentivizes SENDING BEST CANDIDATES
- Timeline:
 - If interested in hosting, send proposal to competitions@panamericanboxing.org by **July 20**
 - Sport & Competition Committee will review proposals and pose follow up questions – finalizing recommendation to board by **July 25**
 - PBC will make recommendation to World Boxing by **July 31**
- Additional opportunities in 2027+

 - Pan American region - Q4 2027
 - World Qualifiers – March & May 2028
 - World Boxing Cups – 2027-2029

- **July 20** – Deadline for proposal to host 2026 PBC R&J Evaluation Course for Continental Pathway (email competitions@panamericanboxing.org)
- **July 31** - Deadline for bids to host 2nd Pan American Games Qualifier (Q1 2027) and U19 or U19/U17 PanAmerican Championships (May/June 2027)
- Bidding guidelines and applications (PBC events and LA28 Qualifiers) found on our website - panamericanboxing.org/qualification-and-bidding
- Competition Manual for October's PanAmerican Elite Continental Championship distributed in next 2 weeks; registration begins end of July
