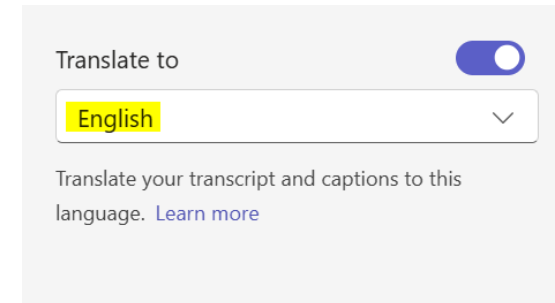
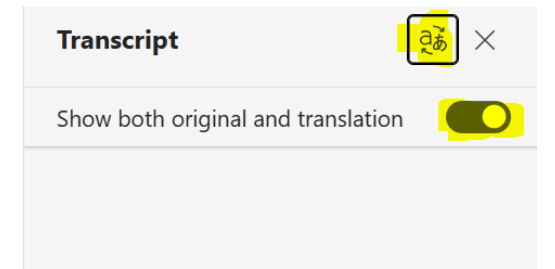
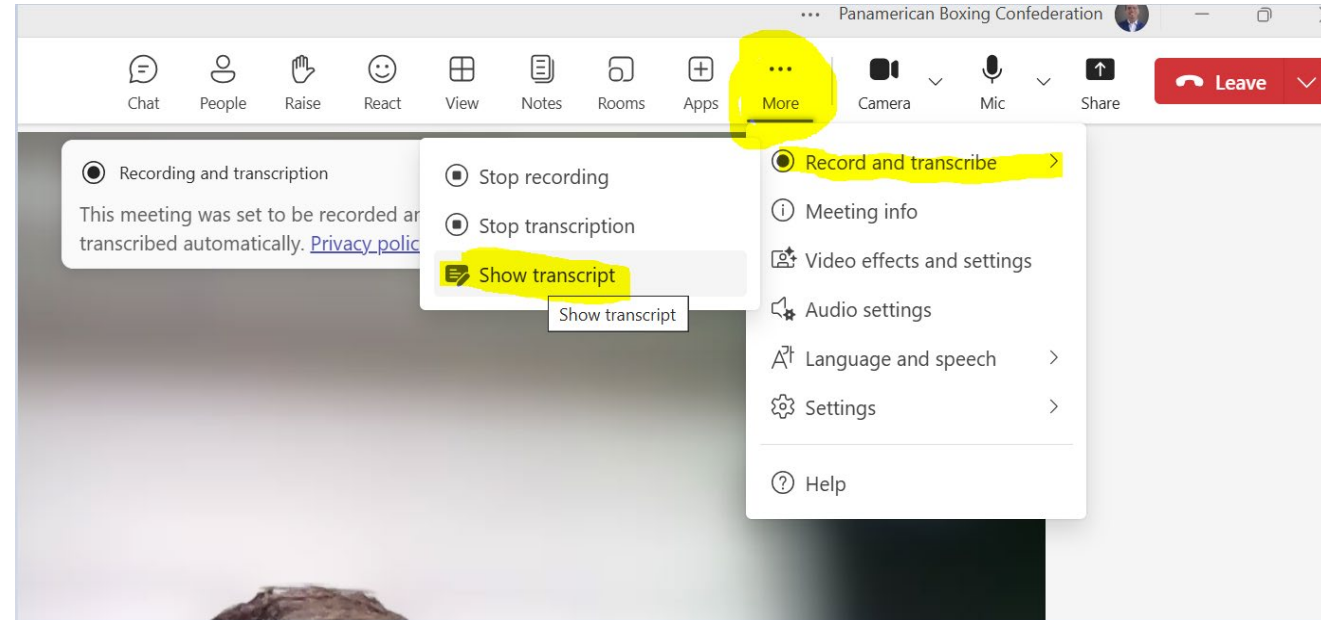

# International Event - Criteria

1. According to rule 1.3.1 of Competition Rules, international competitions must follow World Boxing rules and may only include boxers from member National Federations.
2. Request for endorsement must be initiated by National Federation
3. The tournament must be owned and operated by the host National Federation
4. The Panamerican Boxing Confederation Sport & Competition Committee must approve the event handbook at least two weeks before registration begins.
5. The host National Federation must allow a Confederation-approved official to inspect the venue before the competition. Cost responsibilities will be mutually agreed upon, though with an understanding and commitment to being reasonable.



- ✓ **The Confederation will define and support communication strategy to National Federations members**
- ✓ **To maximize the likelihood of endorsement, please ensure all relevant information is communicated at least three months prior to the event start date.**

1. De acuerdo con la regla 1.3.1 del Reglamento de Competencias, las competiciones internacionales deben registrarse por las normas de World Boxing y solo pueden incluir boxeadores pertenecientes a Federaciones Nacionales miembros.
2. La solicitud de respaldo debe ser iniciada por la Federación Nacional.
3. El torneo debe ser propiedad y estar operado por la Federación Nacional anfitriona.
4. El Comité de Deporte y Competencia de la Confederación Panamericana de Boxeo debe aprobar el manual del evento al menos dos semanas antes del inicio del período de inscripción.
5. La Federación Nacional anfitriona debe permitir la presencia de un funcionario aprobado por la Confederación para inspeccionar el lugar de competencia antes del inicio del evento. Las responsabilidades de los costos serán acordadas mutuamente.



- ✓ **La Confederación definirá y respaldará la estrategia de comunicación hacia las Federaciones Nacionales miembros.**
- ✓ **Para maximizar la probabilidad de obtener el respaldo, asegúrese de comunicar toda la información relevante al menos tres meses antes de la fecha de inicio del evento.**

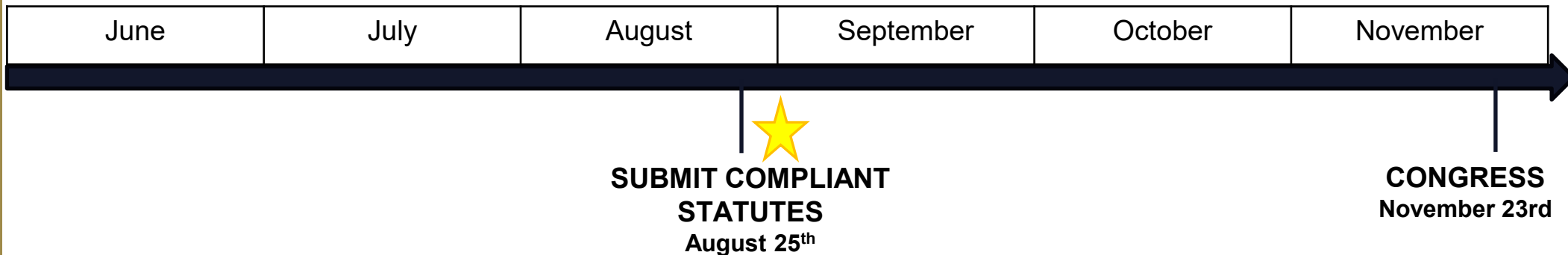
