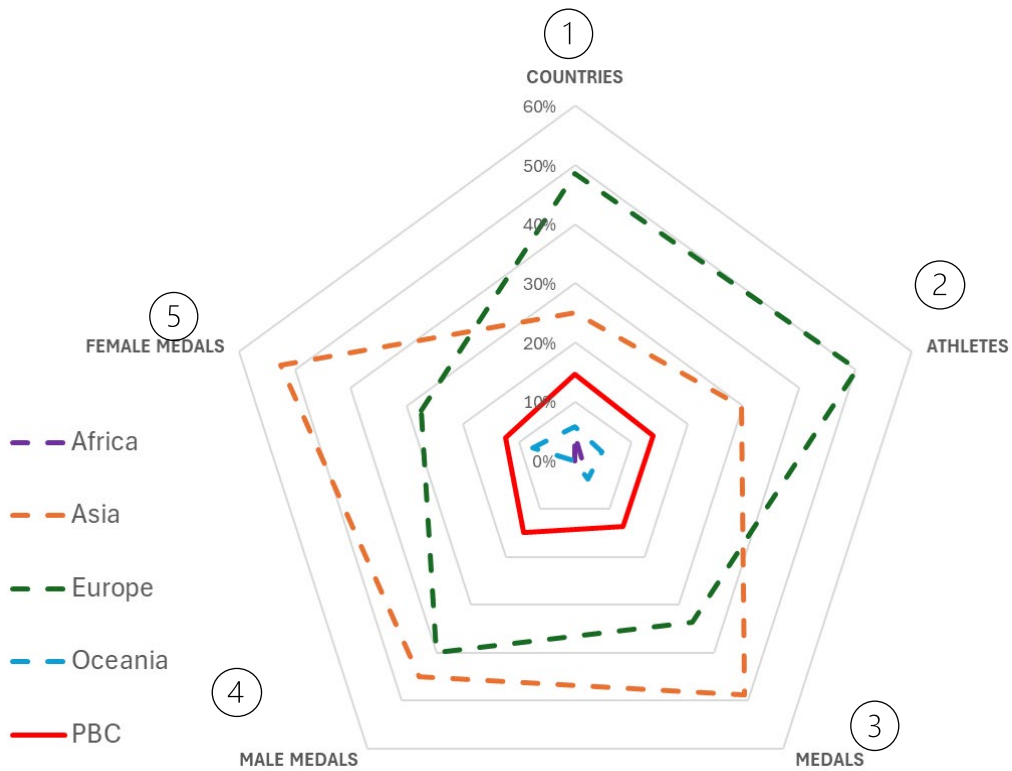

Reminder: Competition Rules

- **Eligibility policy** communicated May 30 by WB (including Gender Testing) and formally took **effect August 20th 2025**; can be found on World Boxing's website https://worldboxing.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/08/World-Boxing-Sex-Eligibility-Policy_FINAL_20Aug25.pdf. Addresses boxers over the age of 18.
 - **National Federations** will be **responsible for testing** and will be required to confirm the gender of their athletes when entering them into World Boxing competitions **by providing a certification** of their chromosomal sex, as determined by a PCR test or a functional medical equivalent genetic test.
 - **A single lifetime test is currently required** for those participating in the **female category**; testing will be necessary for the **male category starting January 1, 2026**. DO NOT WAIT!
 - Applies to all World Boxing-owned and sanctioned competitions (i.e., includes continental competitions, multi-sport games)
 - Critical: **Females** participating in **Central American Games & Bolivarian Games MUST prove eligibility – Certification to be provided during Sport Entry Check.**
- World Boxing members must comply with World Boxing rules (6.20iii of World Boxing Statutes – Obligations of Full Members)
 - World Boxing Competition Rules 1.3 – International Competitions:
 - Owned by host National Federation – should be open to all National Federations affiliated to World Boxing
 - Boxers are entered by their own National Federations in accordance with event invitation
 - Local Organizing Committee will only accept entries that comply with World Boxing Statutes and Competition Rules
 - For endorsement by Panamerican Boxing Confederation (e.g., social media promotion, email promotion)
 - Request must come from organizing National Federation
 - the Confederation Sport & Competition Committee must approve the event handbook at least two weeks prior to event registration
 - The host National Federation must allow a Confederation-approved official to inspect the venue before the competition. Cost responsibilities will be mutually agreed upon, though with an understanding and commitment to being reasonable

Purpose

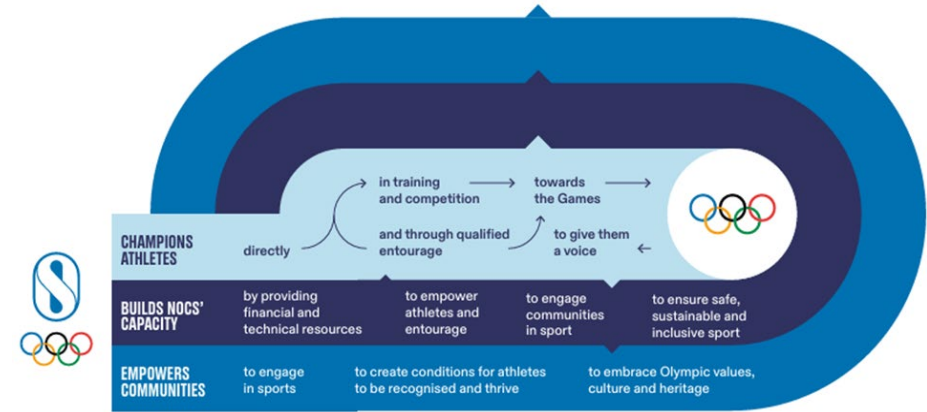
Support Olympic-calibre athletes in preparing and qualifying for the Games, with a focus on universality, gender parity, and smaller delegations. (Help level the playing field)

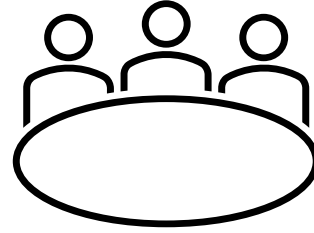
OLYMPIC SOLIDARITY 2025-2028 PLAN

Key Features

- 6 scholarships per NOC
- Monthly assistance or flexible lump-sum grants
- Training, competition & qualification support
- Entourage & coach development
- Career transition & athlete representation
- **Applications must be submitted through each country's National Olympic Committee (NOC)**



Athletes' Committees



Establishing and maintaining an active Athletes' Committee within National Federations (NFs) is not merely a governance formality; it is a **fundamental requirement**

- Ensuring Athlete Voice & Representation
- Promoting Athlete Welfare and Rights
- Enhancing Governance and Credibility and Upholding Ethical Standards
- Fostering a Culture of Athlete-Centricity and Robust Sporting Environment

Currently 36% of National Federations (Full Members and Endorsed Organizations) do not have an Athlete Committee (11 National Federations)

- The Confederation to **gather Names of current Athletes Representatives** to build a **strong community** amongst Athletes.
- The Confederation to contact National Federations without Athletes' Committees to provide necessary steps to have Athletes' Committees up and running within the next 6 months with policies and procedures defined.



Committees & Commissions

- World Boxing vetting R&J candidates submitted through Panamerican Boxing Confederation registration window in July/August
- Medical & Anti-Doping Committee are drafting criteria and will evaluate submitted CVs of ringside physicians
- Athletes Committee – Requires 2 more males (1 must be from Central America)
- Finance Committee – 3 available positions
- Coaches Commission – positions available
- R&J Commission – positions available
- Event Management Commission – positions available
- Media Commission – positions available
- Marketing Commission – positions available
