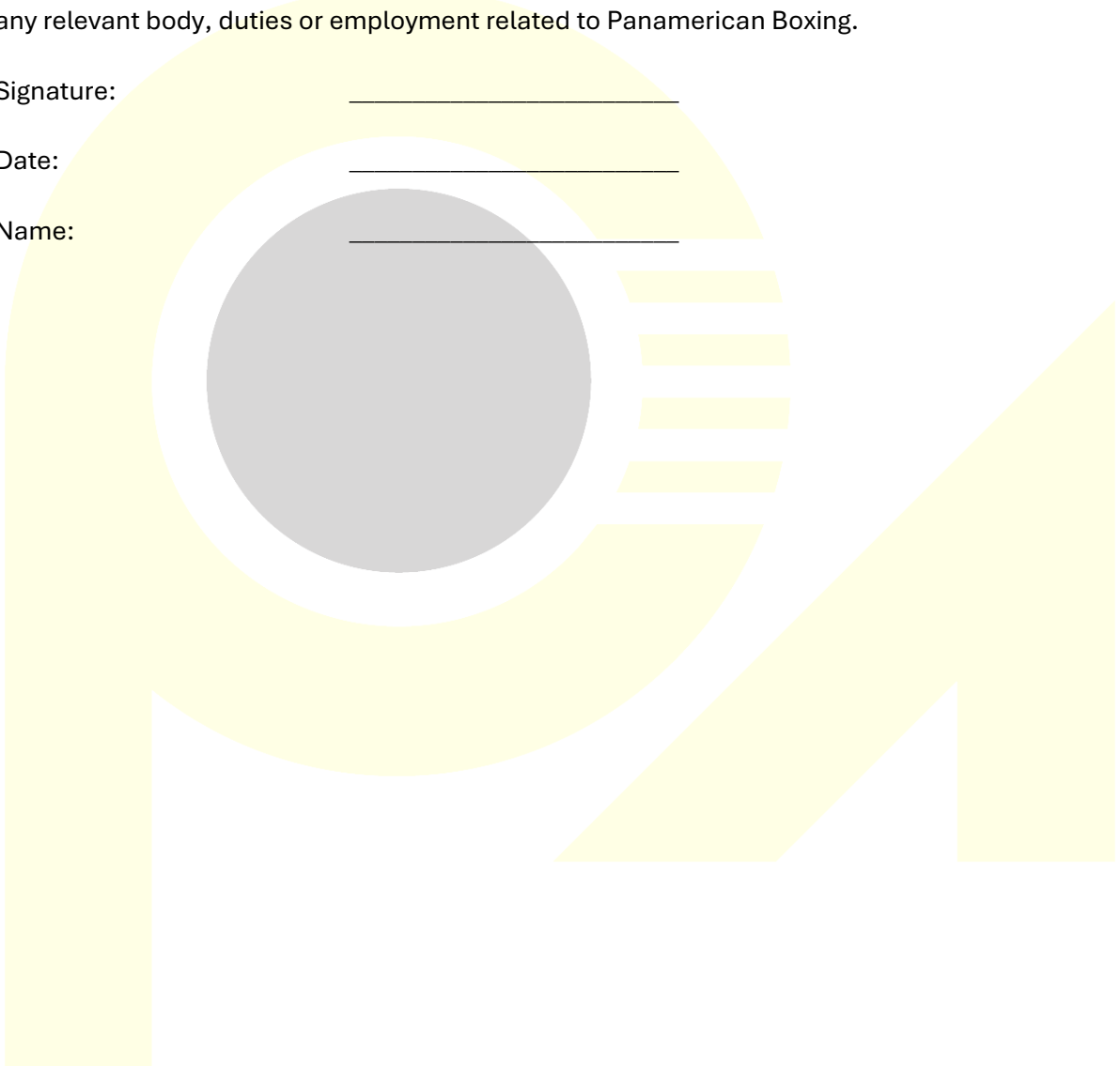

**World Boxing Code of Ethics and
Code of Conduct Stakeholder
and Participant Agreement**

Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct Stakeholder and Participant Agreement

To ensure fair, transparent and well-run competitions for the boxers, World Boxing requires that all boxers, coaches, their entourage, office bearers, Committee and Commission members, officials, Referees and Judges, Continental Confederation members, staff, and other stakeholders and individuals involved in the activities of World Boxing adhere to the highest standards of good governance. This document requires each individual to agree to those standards.

I have read, understood and agree to be bound by the:

- World Boxing Statutes;
- World Boxing Code of Conduct;
- World Boxing Code of Ethics;
- World Boxing Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions;
- World Boxing Safeguarding Policy;
- World Boxing Ethics and Judicial Procedures.

I acknowledge that any infringement of the aforementioned Codes and Rules may be referred to the World Boxing Ethics Chief and may lead to disciplinary measures and sanctions taken against me in accordance with World Boxing Ethics and Judicial Procedures.

I understand that at the point of an alleged breach being reported relating to any of the aforementioned Codes or Rules during a competition or other World Boxing activity, that my accreditation or any other privileges I may hold at that time, may be suspended or removed without prejudice whilst an investigation is conducted.

I understand and agree that this document must be signed at the start of my role with World Boxing and is renewed regularly at least annually. For boxers, coaches and other team members attending World Boxing competitions or competitions operating under the jurisdiction of World Boxing must accept these conditions as part of the entry process for that competition or will be unable to participate.

Enforcement

Any person or stakeholder involved in World Boxing and its activities, who violates or condones a violation of World Boxing Statutes, Code of Ethics, Code of Conduct and the aforementioned Rules and Regulations is subject to the World Boxing Ethics and Judicial disciplinary procedures and measures which may include termination of employment and/or expulsion from their role in World Boxing.
