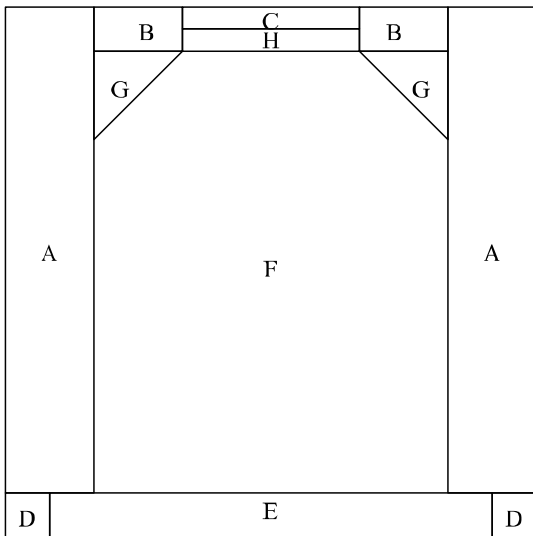
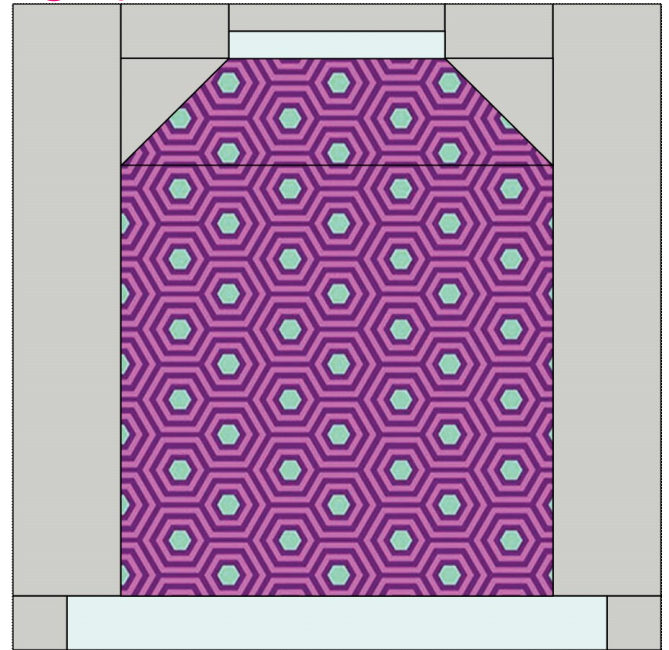





THREAD CONE QUILT BLOCK

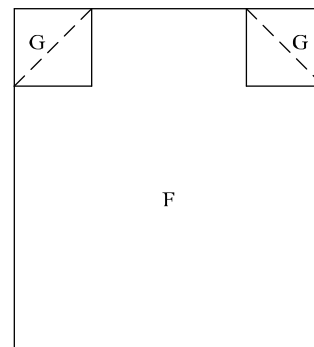


Finished Size: 6"



| Color | | Piece | Size |
|---|------------|-------|-------------------------|
|  | Background | A | 6 x 1 1/2" - Cut 2 |
| | | B | 1 x 1 1/2" - Cut 2 |
| | | C | 2 1/2" x 3/4" - Cut 1 |
| | | D | 1" x 1" - Cut 2 |
| | | G | 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" - Cut 2 |
|  | Spool | E | 5 1/2" x 1" - Cut 1 |
| | | H | 2 1/2" x 3/4" - Cut 1 |
|  | Thread | F | 4 1/2" x 5 1/2" - Cut 1 |

1. With right sides together, align squares G over top left and top right corners of thread F. Sew corner to corner ("snowball") the corners. Trim 1/4 from the sewn line. Press seam



2. H to C along long sides to make spool cap unit. Stitch B pieces to either side to complete spool cap unit
3. Stitch spool cap unit to top of thread to complete thread unit.
4. Stitch one A piece to the left of the thread unit. Stitch the other piece A to the right of the thread unit.
5. Stitch one D piece to the left of the spool base unit. Stitch remaining D to the right of the spool base unit.
6. Stitch spool base unit to thread unit.
7. The completed block should measure 6 1/2"

Notes: Use 1/4" seams. Press after each seam.
