

Instructions for Organising EU Enlargement Workshop

Summary: This workshop is to help participants understand the 9 steps of the EU Enlargement Process. This will also learn about where Ukraine, The Republic of Moldova, and Georgia are on those Enlargement journeys. Ideally, it is great if at the end they can also hear YEAs from those countries share their thoughts & experiences about what EU Enlargement means to them. This makes it more personal and relatable.

Workshop Practicalities:

Ideally at least **2 YEAs** to help deliver the session

Length: **Minimum 1 hour**, but can be longer if you want to extend the discussion at the end

Participants: Any number! We have done this with 20-100 participants.

Location: Mostly done in-person, but can also be organised online too.

You will need:

- Powerpoint Presentation
 - You can find the [Canva PPT here!](#) **Make a COPY of it** (do not edit the template!)
- Laptop, Projector
- Print copies of the [EU Enlargement Cards here](#). Cut out the cards, and place each set in a different envelope (so you don't lose them or mix them). Each group will need 1 set of the cards.

Overview

Time	Activity
10 minutes	Introductions: the Young European Ambassadors Initiative, EU NEIGHBOURS EAST
5 minutes	Introduction to EU Enlargement + Give instructions for what the groups need to do with the EU Enlargement Cards (each group will get 1 set and you need to work together to try to put the cards in the correct order of the different steps that a country takes to join the EU)
5 minutes	Share: Have the groups talk through their thoughts with each other
10 minutes	Review the correct order of the steps together

10 minutes	Look at where Ukraine, Republic of Moldova, and Georgia are in those journeys
20 minutes	Discussion: YEAs share about what EU Enlargement means to them to bring a more personal side to the conversations

You can decide to give more/less time to different parts of the activity, and also make it longer than 1 hour if you think it needs more time.
