

Step 3: Choose Your Book Type

Many Christian authors write in one of these formats:

- Devotional
- Short daily readings with scripture and reflection.
- Teaching Book
- Biblical principles explained with examples.
- Testimony / Story
- Your journey and how God worked in your life.
- Guide or Workbook
- Helping readers apply biblical principles practically.

— Step 4: Create Your Book Outline

Your outline is the **roadmap** of your book.

Start with **8–12 chapters**.

Example structure:

Chapter 1 — Your Story / Introduction

Chapter 2 — The Struggle

Chapter 3 — What God Taught You

Chapter 4 — Key Biblical Principles

Chapter 5 — Applying the Lessons

Chapter 6 — Walking in Transformation

— Step 5: Create a Simple Writing Plan

Most books are not finished because people wait for inspiration.

Instead, create a **simple writing rhythm**.

Example:

Write **500 words per day**

5 days per week

You could finish your manuscript in **6–8 weeks**.

— Common Mistakes New Authors Make

Avoid these common pitfalls:

- ✗ Waiting until everything is perfect
- ✗ Writing without a clear audience
- ✗ Trying to write everything at once
- ✗ Editing while writing

Instead:

- ✓ Write first
- ✓ Edit later
- ✓ Focus on consistency
