Subject: Systemic Reform for Cold Case Investigations and Adoptive Child Safety Nets

Dear Senator [Last Name],

I am writing to you today to advocate for comprehensive legislative reform aimed at protecting adopted youth and modernizing our state's approach to long-term cold cases. The horrific timeline of the Aundria Bowman case demonstrates what happens when systemic oversight fails across state lines and across decades.

Aundria Bowman was adopted into a household where her adoptive father had prior convictions for violent assault, yet a lack of continuous, cross-jurisdictional post-placement monitoring allowed her environment to remain dangerously unvetted. Furthermore, when she went missing, her biological family and advocates were left without legal recourse or transparency for thirty years until investigative genetic genealogy finally linked her killer to a separate cold case.

To prevent such compounding failures, we need robust, state-wide legislative mandates. I urge you to introduce or co-sponsor legislation that focuses on two key pillars:

- **Enhanced Post-Adoption Protections:** Strengthening the tracking, background check parameters, and welfare safety nets for children placed in adoptive homes, ensuring that parental history of violence permanently bars placement and triggers ongoing protective monitoring.
- **Mandatory Cold Case Audits & Funding:** Legislate recurring, mandatory audits of all long-term missing persons and unidentified remains cases within our state, explicitly allocating state funds for advanced forensic tracking, DNA technology, and investigative genetic genealogy.

The tools to solve these cases and protect these children exist today, but law enforcement and advocacy groups lack the statutory mandates and funding to deploy them consistently. As our Senator, you have the power to create a legislative framework that ensures justice is not delayed for decades. If you would like more information, please visit www.AlexisLaw.org.
