Alexis’s Law is urgently needed to fix these dangerous gaps by:

- Requiring strict, ongoing background checks and monitoring of adoptive and foster parents
- Imposing real penalties on professionals who fail to report or investigate abuse
- Funding rapid DNA testing and cold case reviews for missing adopted children
- Requiring transparency and accountability in the adoption system nationwide
