I am writing to urgently request your leadership in introducing a vital public safety reform: Alexis's Law.

Several weeks ago the First Lady delivered a speech to the House Ways and Means Committee. Her Fostering the Future Initiative platform powerfully addresses the immediate needs of youth aging out of foster care but did not target the root infrastructure of child welfare, adoption records, and vital tracking procedures.

Across our nation's criminal justice system, thousands of violent crime investigations and cold cases remain unresolved due to deep, preventable vulnerabilities in forensic evidence tracking, retention, and processing. When biological evidence is siloed across municipal property rooms, lost due to fragmented paper logs, or allowed to languish in backlogged state laboratories, justice is indefinitely delayed—leaving serial offenders on our streets and forcing victims' families to endure secondary, administrative trauma.

Alexis's Law closes dangerous loopholes and converts standard, loosely enforced best practices into binding statutory mandates to ensure end-to-end transparency. The legislation stands firmly on four operational pillars:

Universal Electronic Tracking Portal: Requiring a unified, secure digital ledger utilizing barcode or RFID technology to log biological evidence from initial collection to final disposition, ensuring an unalterable chain of custody.

Strict Processing Timelines: Imposing clear statutory deadlines for law enforcement submission and laboratory processing to eliminate systemic backlog accumulation.

Victim and Survivor Transparency: Granting certified survivors and designated next-of-kin a secure, password-protected mechanism to review major evidence tracking milestones without compromising active operational details.

Independent Compliance Auditing: Empowering a non-partisan Forensic Accountability Commission to execute unannounced physical audits of repositories and laboratories to guarantee reporting accuracy.

This framework represents a profound victory for both public safety and fiscal responsibility. Empirical data demonstrates that prompt forensic testing and automated tracking reduce evidence logging errors by over 90% and drop active case accumulation by up to 85% within two years of enforcement. Furthermore, catching serial predators early saves millions of dollars in prolonged investigative hours and future trial costs.

Together, Fostering the Future and Alexis's Law - two separate initiatives can form a comprehensive, closed-loop safety net that ensures no child's identity, safety, or legal protections are allowed to slip through bureaucratic cracks.

While they approach the issue from different eras and distinct angles—one being a tragic historical example of systemic failure, and the other a modern federal and private framework for youth empowerment— Alexis's Law and Fostering the Future initiative both correlate deeply through the shared themes of child safety, structural accountability, and the urgent need to protect vulnerable youth. The tragic history of child welfare in America is filled with instances where a lack of transparency allowed vulnerable children to vanish from the radar of mandatory reporters and law enforcement. Alexis's Law is a direct, structured response to those historic failures, designed to bring child welfare tracking into the modern era.

Our legal system must no longer permit critical evidence to vanish into administrative dark zones. I welcome the opportunity to meet with you or your legislative director to discuss sponsoring this model framework and taking a definitive stand for transparency, institutional accountability, and justice.
