

Registration Terms – Shamanic Retreat

1. Purpose

These terms govern registration and participation in the retreat organized by SACRED MEDICINE TOURS. By registering, participants accept these terms in full.

2. Registration

- Registration is considered confirmed once full payment or the agreed deposit has been received.
- Registration is transferable only with organizer approval.
- Minimum age requirement: 18 years old.

3. Payment

- Payments may be made via Stripe, PayPal, cryptocurrency, or other methods agreed upon with the organizer.
- All transaction or conversion fees are the responsibility of the participant.
- SACRED MEDICINE TOURS will cover booking platform processing fees.
- Prices are in Mexican Pesos. Any international payment involving currency conversion fees will be the responsibility of the participant.

4. Cancellation and Refunds

- Cancellation 2 months prior → full refund minus 10% processing fee.
- Cancellation 1 month prior → partial refund of 50%.
- Cancellation less than 1 month prior → no refund, unless another participant can replace the spot. In that case, a 100% refund minus 10% processing fee is allowed.
- If the retreat is cancelled by the organizer, a voucher may be issued for a similar future retreat valid for up to one year, or payments will be fully refunded within a maximum of one year.

5. Participant Responsibility

- Participants are fully responsible for their physical, mental, and emotional health.
- Participants with relevant medical conditions must inform the external ceremony organizer prior to registration and may be required to provide a medical certificate or clearance. SACRED MEDICINE TOURS acts solely as administrative and logistical support in coordination with the external facilitators.”
- Participation in retreat activities and ceremonies is entirely voluntary, and participants agree to follow all safety instructions.

6. Limitation of Liability

- SACRED MEDICINE TOURS acts solely as the organizer of the retreat.
- The organizer does not conduct the shamanic ceremonies and is not responsible for incidents related to the practices.

- Participants acknowledge that they take part in ceremonies at their own risk and must sign a waiver of liability if they plan to participate.

7. Conduct

- Participants agree to respect other participants, the group, and the natural environment.
- Any behavior deemed dangerous or inappropriate may result in expulsion from the retreat without refund.

8. Personal Data

- Information collected is used solely for retreat management.
- Data is protected in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

9. Force Majeure

- The organizer is not responsible for cancellations or disruptions due to force majeure (natural disasters, political events, health restrictions, etc.).
- In such cases, options for rescheduling or refund will be offered.

10. Acceptance

- Registration implies full acceptance of these terms.
- Any incomplete or non-compliant registration may be refused.
