💡 You don't need perfect photos—just clear ones with good lighting.

There are Three paths to creating avatars:

Avatar Type	Best For
Digital You	Personal branding, coaching, content creation
Digital Spokesperson	Business, marketing, training videos
Digital Character	Virtual influencers, storytelling, anonymous brands



All of the above approaches can be highly effective. The best choice depends on your goals, audience, and comfort level being the face of your content.

Photo Checklist

Before uploading your photos, make sure they meet the following requirements:

✓

Clear and In Focus

Your face should be sharp and easy to see.

Good:

- Clear eyes and facial features
- High-quality smartphone images
- Well-focused photos

Avoid:

- Blurry photos
- Pixelated images
- Photos taken from far away



✓ Good Lighting

Lighting helps the AI capture your facial details accurately.

Best options:

- Natural daylight

Let's Start With The Personal Avatar

Before You Begin: Choosing the Right Photos for Your Avatar

The quality of your avatar depends heavily on the quality and variety of the photos you upload.

Think of your photos as the "training material" your avatar uses to learn what you look like. The more accurately your photos represent you, the more realistic and professional your avatar will appear.

Your Goal

Upload **5–10 clear photos** that show:

- Your face clearly
- Different angles
- Different expressions
- Good lighting
- Your current appearance

You do **not** need professional photos. Most students achieve excellent results using photos taken with a smartphone.

The AI needs to see your face from multiple perspectives.

Try to include:

- 3 front-facing photos
- 2 photos turned slightly left
- 2 photos turned slightly right
- 1 photo looking slightly up
- 1 photo looking slightly down

This helps create a more accurate and realistic avatar.



Include Different Expressions

Examples:

- Neutral expression
- Small smile
- Broad smile
- Professional look
- Relaxed look

Facing a window for natural lighting
Bright indoor lighting

Avoid

- Dark rooms
- Strong shadows across your face
- Bright light behind you
- Colored party or stage lighting

Tip: A simple selfie near a window often produces excellent results.

Include Different Angles



✓Avoid uploading ten photos with exactly the same expression.

Show Your Current Appearance

Your photos should reflect how you look today.

If possible:

- Use recent photos

- Use your current hairstyle

- Use your current facial hair style

✓Avoid mixing photos from several years apart if your appearance has changed significantly.

Use Solo Photos

The best photos contain only you.

Good:

- Individual portraits

- Selfies

- Professional headshots

Avoid:

- Group photos

- Family pictures

- Photos where faces overlap

The AI should be able to identify you immediately.

✓ **Mix Casual and Professional Photos**

A variety of styles helps create a more flexible avatar.

Examples:

- Casual clothing

- Business attire

- Everyday photos

- Professional headshots

This gives the AI more information to work with.

Once you've completed your first avatar video, you've successfully moved from learning about AI avatars to actually using them.

Glasses, Hats, and Accessories

If you normally wear glasses:

- Include some photos with glasses

- Include some photos without glasses

If you wear hats regularly:

- Use only a few hat photos

Make sure most photos clearly show your hair and face

Avoid:

- Sunglasses

- Face masks

- Anything that hides key facial features

Common Mistakes to Avoid

- × Blurry images
- × Photos taken in poor lighting
- × Heavy filters or beauty filters
- × Sunglasses in every photo
- × Group photos
- × Photos taken from a long distance
- × Uploading only one or two photos

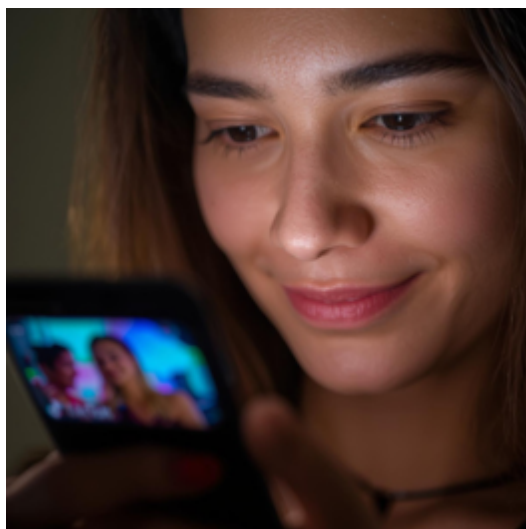
Quick Success Formula

If you're short on time, simply take:

1. Five photos facing a window.
2. Use a mix of smiles and neutral expressions.
3. Capture front, left, and right angles.
4. Wear clothing you normally wear.
5. Upload the photos immediately.

You'll have everything needed to create a realistic, professional avatar.

Remember: Variety beats perfection. Ten clear smartphone photos taken in good lighting will usually outperform one perfect professional headshot.



Creating Your First Avatar with HeyGen

HeyGen is one of the easiest platforms for creating realistic AI avatars and videos. In this guide, you'll create your first avatar and generate your first piece of content.

Step 1: Create Your Account

Visit HeyGen and create your account.

Once logged in, take a few minutes to explore the dashboard and familiarize yourself with the available tools and options.

Don't worry about learning every feature. For now, focus on creating your first avatar.

Step 2: Decide What You're Creating

Before uploading anything, decide which type of avatar you want to build:

- ✗ Blurry photos
- ✗ Group pictures

The quality of your photos directly impacts the quality of your avatar.
