Horses entered in any WB or NB Class must meet the current Association's Rule Book requirements. All required cards must be presented at the entry booth. Judge's decision is final. **Chains/Rollers are not allowed** on any horse while riding or working on the show grounds. Pawing and /or kicking chains will be allowed in the stall and/or trailer.
