

WHOSE SIDE ARE THEY ON?

On Tuesday, April 14th, at 6:00PM, Ontario's MPPs will stand up in the Legislature and choose between injured workers and employers.

The MPPs will be called on to debate and vote on the Meredith Act, aka Private Member's Bill 86. The Meredith Act will repeal the workers' compensation system created by Mike Harris to boost employer profits. It will create a comprehensive system that protects injured workers and gives them a REAL chance to rebuild their lives and support their families.

Your representatives will do one of two things on April 14th. Either they will stand with injured workers, their families, and their communities, or they will be publicly named and shamed as champions of the rich and powerful.

Is your Union Local prepared to go to your MPPs and tell them which side you expect them to be on?

Support the Ontario Network of Injured Workers' Groups and send a delegation to your local MPPs. Tell them what you want, and what you expect them to do!

It is a stark choice between right and wrong.

On April the 14th, you will know where your MPPs stand.

Will you, organized Labour, hold them to account?

Or will you allow them to deliver yet another victory to their employer friends?
