

PICKLEPOP VENUE SETUP GUIDELINES

PicklePop Venue Setup Guidelines

To ensure safe installation of the portable pickleball court, the venue must meet the following requirements.

1. Minimum Space Requirement

The recommended space required for a PicklePop court setup is:

Approximately 16 meters (length) × 9 meters (width)

This includes:

- the pickleball court area
 - side clearance for player movement
 - safety space around the court

2. Flat Surface Requirement

The playing area must be **flat and stable**.

A **slight slope is acceptable**, but the surface should not have:

- large dips
- uneven gaps
- unstable ground

Uneven surfaces may affect the installation of the modular court system.

3. Suitable Ground Surfaces

PicklePop courts can be installed on the following surfaces:

- concrete
- cement
- indoor gym floors
- covered courts
- parking areas
- subdivision roads

- pavement
- interlocking pavers

These surfaces provide stable support for the modular flooring system.

4. Surfaces That May Require Assessment

The following surfaces may be acceptable depending on flatness:

- brick pavement
- stone pavers

Photos of the venue may be requested before approval.

5. Surfaces Not Suitable

Courts cannot be installed on the following surfaces:

- grass
- soil
- sand
- mud
- gravel
- rocky or uneven terrain

These surfaces prevent proper court installation.

6. Venue Preparation

Before our team arrives, please ensure that:

- the area is cleared of vehicles and obstacles
 - the surface is clean and dry
 - the location is accessible for equipment unloading

7. Setup Time

PicklePop staff will arrive approximately **one (1) hour before the scheduled play time** to install the court system.

The installation process includes flooring, net system, barriers, and lighting setup (if applicable).

8. Site Assessment

If you are unsure whether your venue is suitable, you may send **photos or videos of the location** to PicklePop for assessment.

9. Installation Rights

PicklePop reserves the right to decline installation if the venue:

- does not meet safety requirements
- has unsafe or uneven ground conditions
- poses risk to players or equipment
