1. WE ARE GREEN CROSS

Founded by Nobel Laureate **Mikhail Gorbachev** in **1993**, we are an international NGO responding to the combined challenges of security, poverty, and environmental degradation—working to ensure a sustainable and secure future.



We hold **Consultative Status** as an Observer Organization at the **United Nations**, granted in recognition of our vision, commitment, and proven track record of integrity and positive impact. In the UK, we are also proud signatories of the **UN Global Compact**.

2. THE CASE FOR INDEPENDENT STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP

Governments answer to voters. Corporations answer to shareholders. Communities, planetary boundaries, and future generations have no seat where capital allocation decisions are made.

Result: we consume nearly twice what Earth can regenerate. Our systems optimise short-term returns—not the long-term security of those who cannot vote, spend, or lobby. **We exist to balance the scales between all actors.**



Success is measured in results. Thirty years prove that **generating wealth and protecting humanity are not opposing goals**. They are the same. This is not aspiration. This is our mandate.



UNDERSTANDING CAUSES OF GLOBAL CHANGE

These causes do not operate in isolation—neither do our **sustainable solutions**. Each Green Cross UK programme and initiative integrates multiple domains to address root causes, not symptoms, whilst generating measurable economic value.



GLOBAL CONTEXT

3. SYSTEMIC CONVERGENCE REQUIRES SYSTEMIC RESPONSE

- Humanity is breaching six of nine planetary boundaries whilst failing to meet foundational social needs — United Nations Environment Programme.



- Seven of the top ten long-term global risks are socio-environmental, with economic and geopolitical crises directly linked — World Economic Forum, Global Risks Report 2025.
- The Doomsday Clock stands at 85 seconds to midnight — the closest it has ever been — Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists, January 2026.

This is not merely climate change.

This is systemic convergence: Resource Depletion, Social Fracture, Institutional Failure, and Collapsing Time to Recalibrate.



Sustainability operates at the intersection of Governance, Just Transition, Finance, Climate Action, Resilience, Collaboration, Innovation, Engagement, Equity, and Inclusion.

Each domain is complex on its own. All interconnected. None solvable in isolation.

This is the arena where Green Cross UK acts. Here we mitigate and adapt to global change—representing those without institutional voice, aligning incentives to generate positive impact, and restoring trust where systems fail.

4. WHERE COORDINATION IS REQUIRED

Addressing systemic convergence requires coordination across public institutions, private capital, technology providers, and communities. Each brings essential capacity. Each operates under different mandates and timeframes.

The challenge is not competence. The challenge is alignment. When economic incentives reward engagement duration over outcome demonstration, or when institutional constraints prevent adaptive management, systemic solutions stall—**not from lack of will, but from structural friction.**

This is where Green Cross UK operates: coordinating where mandates diverge and verifying where outcomes must withstand scrutiny.

OPERATING MODEL

5. INTEGRATION THROUGH TAILORED CUSTOMISATION

Drawing on over 30 years of experience across 25 countries, Green Cross UK operates through a **curated global network of specialists**—activated by need, selected for competence, and accountable for outcomes.

We respond systemically. When a challenge arises, we convene the right experts — selected for technical competence and contextual fit.

1. **FORMULATE:** We analyse each need as a complex system: multidimensional, multidisciplinary, where isolated actions rarely produce lasting change — because parts do not sum to the whole. We identify cross-cutting implications and leverage points.


2. **RESOLVE:** We design tailored solutions using our programmes as a framework. We balance competing priorities, define roles, KPIs, and economic variables, ensuring no conflicts of interest.

3. **PLAN:** We develop a roadmap, coordinating technology providers, certifiers, legal advisors, community facilitators, and financial structures — each selected for competence. We address technical change and community engagement.

4. **EXECUTE:** We oversee execution through external providers—ensuring quality without direct intervention. Contracts sit between provider and funder; we act as project managers, safeguarding technical integrity.


5. **REVISE:** We verify outcomes through the most appropriate mechanism for each engagement: energy saved, ecosystems restored, carbon verified, finance mobilised. Our commitment is to measurable results, proportionate to context.

Political contexts shift. Partners change. Technologies evolve. We do not. That continuity is our function.



HOW WE APPROACH EVERY CHALLENGE

6. THE FIVE PRINCIPLES GUIDE EVERY ENGAGEMENT



1. **Mitigation Hierarchy First:**

→ Avoid → Reduce → Remediate → Restore → Compensate →

Offsets are last resort, never first solution.

2. **Roadmap-Driven Implementation:** Standards are milestones on multi-year journeys. We develop **phased targets** with adaptive management.

3. **Stakeholder Co-Responsibility:** All parties verify milestones together. Legitimacy requires **consent, not merely compliance**.

4. **Technology-Enabled Verification:** Digital MRV, IoT sensors, satellite monitoring, eDNA tracking. Technology **augments human judgment**.

5. **Layered Rigour:** Management systems (ISO), sector standards (ENVISION, IRMA), impact verification (SBTi, TNFD), financial integration (PRI).

These principles transform sustainability from aspiration into verified reality. Every outcome integrates **scientific precision** and **humanistic probity** with stakeholder legitimacy — and demonstrated sustainable value.

Where measurement ends, representation begins.

PROGRAMMATIC SCOPE OF WORK

7. STRATEGIC PROGRAMMES AND TACTICAL INITIATIVES



STRATEGIC LAYER – PROGRAMMES:

- i. **Sustainable Infrastructure (SIπ):** Renewable energy integration, water-neutral systems, zero-emission transport. Infrastructure designed to last generations, not locked into obsolescence.
- ii. **Regenerative Agriculture (RAπ):** Restoring soil health, preserving biodiversity, strengthening food security. Transforming extraction into regeneration through decentralised storage and carbon programmes.
- iii. **Responsible Mining (RMπ):** Circular metal recovery, ecosystem restoration, community benefit structures. Supplying the green transition without perpetuating extraction's historical harms.
- iv. **Peace-Building (PBπ):** An itinerant voyage for peace and sustainability—sailing to unite cultures, inspire coordinated action, and demonstrate that lasting security requires environmental stewardship.

TACTICAL LAYER – INITIATIVES:

- A. **JU – Decarbonisation:** Instruments, policies, and strategies turning climate commitments into verified emission reductions.
- B. **SAVE – Energy Stewardship:** AI-driven efficiency, insetting programmes, and hybrid system governance for measurable energy transition.
- C. **Legacy – Events with Positive Impact:** Protocols ensuring global gatherings generate regenerative legacy, not carbon debt. Shared responsibility, verified outcomes.
- D. **Lazarus – Biodiversity Restoration:** Sustainable assets financing ecosystem recovery. ARB instruments financing recovery without public budget exposure.

DELIVERING ECONOMIC VALUE, VERIFIED POSITIVE IMPACT

8. OUR FLAGSHIP INITIATIVES

Every Green Cross UK initiative starts from the same point: a tangible challenge with no pre-packaged solution, demanding integrated thinking across environmental and social systems. The following three initiatives demonstrate how this approach creates durable, verifiable value.

I. **ANEYA — Regenerative Agriculture & Decarbonisation, India**

India loses an estimated 10–20 million tonnes of wheat and rice annually to post-harvest inefficiency — a crisis with severe economic, nutritional and environmental consequences. Aneya addresses this by deploying the G3S decentralised storage system, paired with a dual carbon credit programme certified under Verra standards VM0046 and VM0042.

The model first reduces losses, then leverages verified carbon instruments, and ultimately increases farmer income — whilst generating measurable environmental value.

II. **VITALES¹ — Biodiversity Restoration, Peru**

Lake Titicaca faced critical pollution with no public funds for recovery. In response, the Lazarus Initiative structured Assets for Restoring Biodiversity (ARBs — financial instruments backed by verified ecosystem recovery) to self-finance sanitation technology deployment.

This innovative model generates verified biodiversity, water, and carbon instruments aligned with leading frameworks including TNFD, SEEA-EA, and TEV.

III. **SAVE¹ — Energy Stewardship, Global**

An Independent Power Producer (India) managing over 83GW of installed capacity integrated SAVE's AI-driven platform. This resulted in a 22–30% reduction in energy consumption and the creation of certified green finance instruments, meeting rigorous standards such as LEED and ENVISION.

Our independence is structural: no shareholders, no preferential suppliers, and compensation only upon independently verified outcomes. We work alongside partners, aligning objectives with planetary boundaries — transparently, rigorously. Responsibility is shared; structure is our guarantee.

These are not one-off projects. They are replicable models, available globally through our Programmes and Initiatives.
