RE: Juan Vasquez Internship Fundraising

Dear Juan,

This letter is to confirm that you are required to raise financial support in order to participate in the Reaching Japan two-year internship program.

Because this internship requires relocation to Japan, language study, housing, transportation, and basic living expenses, all fundraising must be completed prior to deployment for the field. This will enable you to focus on language learning, cultural adjustment, ministry training, and service alongside the church plant when you arrive.

You will need **\$2,150 USD per month** to cover:

- Basic housing and daily living expenses
- Required local expenses in Japan, such as required Japanese health insurance
- Ministry, training, and educational expenses
- Basic savings and emergency expenses

Japan's cost of living is significantly higher than in some countries, so the costs above reflect what is needed to live responsibly as an intern in Japan.

In addition to monthly support, you will also need to raise approximately **\$10,500 USD** for language school fees for the two-year internship period, as well as approximately **\$3,650 USD** for one-time apartment setup expenses. These setup expenses are for basic furnishings, household essentials, and initial move-in costs.

You will also need to raise additional funds for airfare to and from the field, including your initial travel to Japan and return travel at the conclusion of the internship.

These figures represent the basic minimum amount currently required for you to be deployed to Japan for the 2-year internship and are based on current costs. If economic conditions substantially change prior to deployment, we will notify you of any necessary adjustments.

May the Lord be with you as you do your fundraising for the field.
