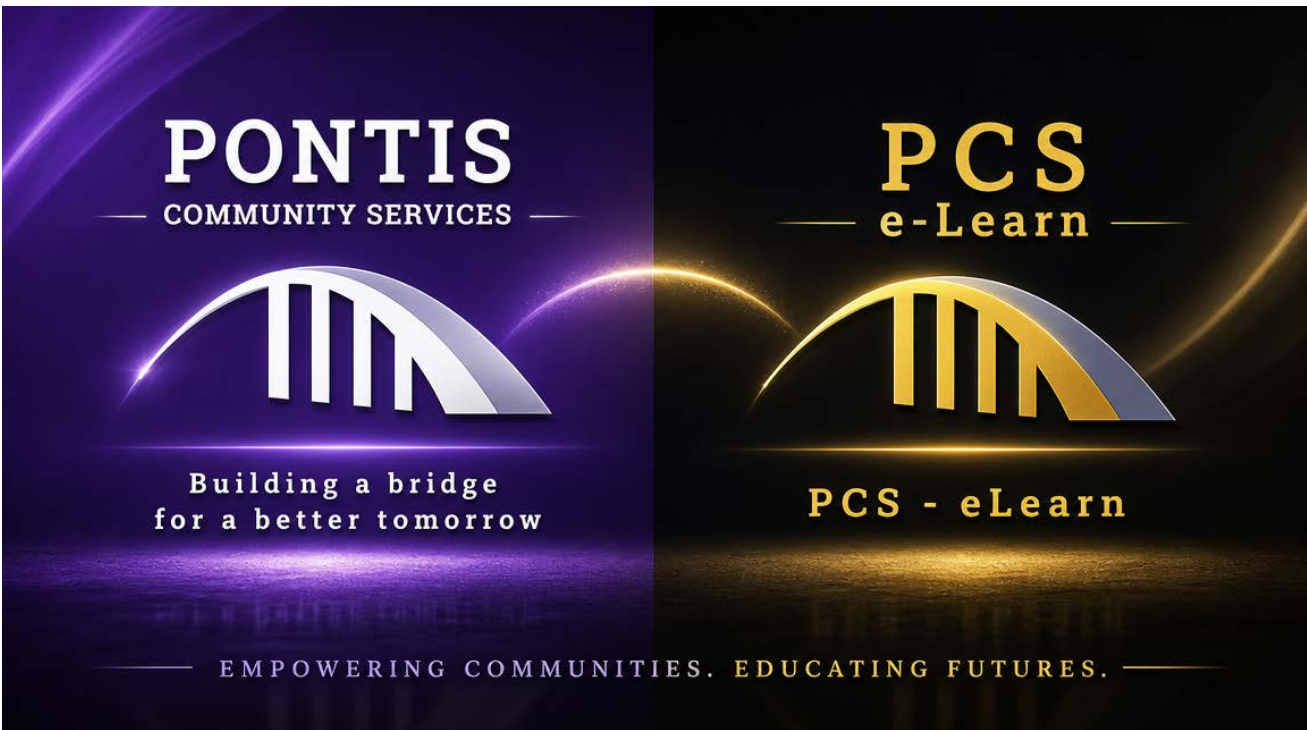




CUSTOMS BROKER LICENSE EXAM COURSE
