



USPTO BAR EXAM COURSE

This USPTO Patent Bar Exam Prep Course is a guided overview of the rules and procedures tested on the USPTO Registration Examination. The course walks students through the fundamentals of patent law and USPTO practice, explaining how patent applications are filed and examined, how examiners issue rejections, and what applicants can do in response. A major focus is learning how to use the Manual of Patent Examining Procedure (MPEP) to quickly locate the correct rule and apply it to common exam-style situations.
