CAI RANG FLOATING MARKET DISCOVERY JOURNEY

Starting Point: Bình An Village

Duration: 04:00 AM – 08:00 AM

🕒 Detailed Itinerary

- **04:00 AM | Departure from Bình An Village**
 - A private taxi will pick you up at the resort gate.
 - **The Drive:** The journey from Vinh Long to Ninh Kieu Wharf (Can Tho) takes approximately 45–55 minutes, crossing the majestic Can Tho Bridge illuminated by night lights.
- **05:00 AM | Arrival at the Pier & Boarding**
 - Your driver will assist you in connecting with the local boat captain.
 - **Procedures:** Boat rental fees are paid directly to the captain (ranging from **350,000 VND to 650,000 VND** depending on the boat type and group size).
 - Set off along the Hau River toward the heart of the floating market.
- **05:30 AM – 07:00 AM | The "Soul" of the Floating Market**
 - **Sunrise Watching:** Capture the most beautiful moments as the first rays of light touch the silt-laden river.
 - **The "Beo" Pole:** Learn about the unique local marketing tradition where vendors hang their goods on long bamboo poles to show what they are selling.
 - **Breakfast on the River:** Don't miss the experience of sitting on a swaying boat while enjoying a steaming bowl of *Hu Tieu* (Tapioca noodles) or *Bun Rieu* (Crab noodle soup) from passing food vendors.
 - **Tropical Fruits:** Pull up alongside a fruit boat to buy fresh pineapples, watermelons, star apples,...
- **07:00 AM | Tour Ends & Return to Bình An Village**
 - The boat returns you to the pier, where your taxi is waiting for the drive back to Bình An Village.
- **08:00 AM | Return to Bình An Village**
 - The taxi drops you off directly at the resort lobby.
 - Unwind and recharge with a leisurely breakfast and a cup of coffee in the peaceful atmosphere of Binh An Village.

Departure: From Bình An Village

- **08:00 AM (or 02:00 PM):** A private taxi will pick you up at Binh An Village for a short drive to the pier.
- Board your motorized boat. Feel the refreshing breeze of the **Tien River** and observe the authentic daily life of locals along the riverbanks.

Tour Highlights & Experiences

The boat will take you to traditional craft villages and specialty orchards:

1. **CocoHome (The Coconut House):** A unique architectural masterpiece built from thousands of coconut trees. It's the perfect spot for stunning "check-in" photos.
2. **Honey Bee Farm:** Sip on warm longan flower honey tea, enjoy local fruit preserves, and learn how the farmers harvest honey.
3. **Rice Popcorn & Coconut Candy Workshop:** Watch the traditional handmade process, try your hand at making candy, and enjoy a warm sample straight off the line (warm coconut candy is a must-try!).
4. **Local Orchards:** Explore lush gardens featuring cantaloupes, longans, and more.

Optional Cultural Activities

If you want a deeper dive into Mekong Delta culture, you can request the following:

- Enjoying seasonal fruits (Rambutan, Longan, Guava, etc.)
- **Ditch fishing** (catching fish by hand/bucket)
- Rowing a traditional **sampan** boat
- Relaxed fishing

A Unique Contemporary Heritage in Vinh Long

Step back in time to a century-old ceramic village—where moss-covered brick "castles" cast their reflections upon the legendary Thay Cai Canal.

🕒 Detailed Itinerary (2.5 Hours)

- **Departure:** Your private car picks you up at the meeting point (**Binh An Village**). We set off along the scenic Provincial Road 902 toward the "capital" of Mang Thit's brick and pottery industry.
- **Check-in at the "Kingdom's Gateway":** Stop at the riverside road at the entrance of the district. Here, rows of ancient brick kilns stand side-by-side, forming a vibrant red fortress under the sun.
- **Wander Among Mossy "Castles":** * Stroll through the iconic dome-shaped brick towers that resemble ancient Cham temples from afar.
 - **A Cinematic Palette:** Experience the striking contrast between the deep red bricks, the green moss, and the vast Mekong Delta sky—perfect for "artistic" photography.
- **Experience the "Soul of the Earth" at a Pottery Workshop:**
 - Visit an active red ceramic factory.
 - **Witness the Craft:** Watch master artisans skillfully navigate the potter's wheel, molding raw clay into sophisticated artworks.
 - Learn the art of "kiln loading"—a meticulous manual arrangement technique that requires absolute precision.
- **Gifts from the Clay:** You can personally select red ceramic souvenirs (vases, figurines, etc.) directly from the workshop at very affordable "factory-direct" prices.
- **The "Canal Life" Experience:** Relax at a riverside café. Take in the panoramic view of the bustling canal, filled with wooden boats overflowing with red bricks—the most iconic image of this region.
- **Return:** Our car takes you back to Binh An Village, concluding your heritage discovery journey.

A JOURNEY TO DISCOVER SA DEC FLOWER VILLAGE

1. Transportation & Estimated Costs

Given the short distance from Vinh Long, you have three main options:

- **Motorbike (Recommended):** Takes about 45–60 minutes via National Highway 80 (QL80). This is the best way to navigate the narrow alleys of the flower village freely.
 - **Cost:** Around **50,000 VNĐ** for fuel.
- **Taxi/Private Car:** Ideal for families or groups of 4–7 people.
 - **Cost:** Approximately **400,000 – 500,000 VNĐ** per way. Alternatively, you can hire a private taxi for the whole day for about **1,300,000 VNĐ**.
- **Bus:** There are interprovincial buses running between Vinh Long and Sa Dec.
 - **Cost:** Very budget-friendly (**20,000 – 30,000 VNĐ**/ticket), but you'll need to wait for the bus and hire a motorbike taxi (xe om) or Grab upon arrival.

Estimated Total Budget (Self-sufficient): Around **300,000 – 500,000 VNĐ/person** (including food, entrance fees, and fuel).

2. Suggested Itinerary: "Morning Blooms, Local Delicacies & Afternoon History"

- **Departure:** Start from **Binh An Village**. You can have breakfast in Vinh Long or head straight to Sa Dec to enjoy the famous **Sa Dec Rice Noodle Soup (Hu tieu Sa Dec)**.
- **Sa Dec Flower Village (Tan Quy Dong):** Visit major gardens like **Hung Thy** or the **Rose Field**. This is the best time for photography as the sunlight is most flattering.
- **Huynh Thuy Le Ancient House:** Explore the unique blend of East-meets-West architecture and hear the romantic story behind the world-famous novel "*The Lover*."
- **Lunch:** Enjoy local specialties like **Fermented Fish Hotpot (Lau mam)**, **Grilled Snakehead Fish**, or **Broken Rice (Com tam)** in central Sa Dec.
- **Kien An Cung Pagoda (Ong Quach Pagoda):** Admire the unique Chinese architecture featuring intricate carvings.
- **Sa Nhien Garden or The Upside Down House:** Modern and fun "check-in" spots perfect for younger travelers.
- **Souvenirs:** Buy local specialties such as **Lai Vung Fermented Pork (Nem)** or **Sa Giang Prawn Crackers** before heading back to Vinh Long.

3. Other Attractions Worth Visiting:

- **Flower Village Observation Deck:** Located at **Ngoc Lan Garden**, this 18m-high deck offers a panoramic view of the vibrant flower carpets from above.
- **Sa Dec Flower Square:** Home to the largest flower basket symbol in Vietnam—the perfect spot for a group commemorative photo.
- **Hung Thy Happy Land:** Beyond the flowers, this park offers traditional folk games like zip-lining, walking on monkey bridges, and rowing—great for groups of friends.
- **Lotus Leaf Pagoda (Phuoc Kien Tu):** Located about 15km from Sa Dec (towards Lai Vung). Here, you can experience standing on **giant lotus leaves** that can support weight up to 80kg.

VINH LONG CITY – A FUSION OF HERITAGE

Estimated Duration: 4 hours (Morning: 08:00 – 12:00 or Afternoon: 13:30 – 17:30)

Transportation: Private Car, Price: ~ 700.000VNĐ

1. Phat Ngoc Xa Loi Pagoda Vinh Long

- **Location:** Tan Ngai Ward (at the foot of My Thuan Bridge).
- **Overview:** One of the largest and most beautiful pagodas in the Mekong Delta. The highlights include a **54m-high stupa** and a **32m-tall statue of Bodhisattva Guan Yin**. Its architecture is both majestic and intricate, making it a perfect spot for both worship and souvenir photos.

2. Van Thanh Mieu (Temple of Literature)

- **Location:** Phuoc Hau Ward.
- **Overview:** Known as the "**Temple of Literature of the South**." This National Historic Site features classic Confucian architecture set in a serene space with ancient trees. It is the ideal place to learn about the region's long-standing tradition of academic excellence.

3. Vinh Long Museum

- **Location:** Long Chau Ward.
- **Overview:** To diversify your experience, explore the local history and culture preserved here. The area is centrally located and very accessible by car, offering a deep dive into the evolution of this riverside city.

4. Vinh Long City Square & Tien River Embankment

- **Location:** Long Chau Ward (City Center).
- **Overview:** Conclude your tour with a relaxing stroll or drive along the embankment. Enjoy the bustling river life and a distant view of the **My Thuan Bridge**. You can stop by a riverside café to soak in the local atmosphere.

✳ Other Famous Attractions:

If you have more time or wish to customize your trip, consider these unique spots around the city:

1. Vinh Long Market (Long Chau Ward): The vibrant and colorful "heart" of the city. More than just a marketplace, it is a cultural crossroads of the Mekong River life.
2. Ong Pagoda (That Phu Mieu - Long Chau Ward): A Chinese temple featuring striking red architecture, intricate ceramic reliefs, and elaborate wood carvings. Conveniently located for travelers.
3. Tu Bui Ceramic House (Thanh Duc Ward): A unique house built entirely from red ceramics—the signature craft of Vinh Long. A highly artistic and creative space.
