Day 1: Arrive Auckland

Today Arrive Auckland pick your rental vehicle and drive towards hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Auckland.

Day 2: Auckland – Auckland City Highlights

Today proceed for the tour. A half day Auckland City Highlights and Sky Tower tour. Start the morning with a comprehensive sightseeing tour of Auckland - New Zealand's largest and most vibrant city known as the City of Sails. Highlights include: Queen Street, Auckland Harbour Bridge, Viaduct Harbour and Wynyard Quarter. A stop will be made at the Auckland Museum (admission not included) and the winter gardens. Finish the day with a visit to Sky Tower. Tour concludes approximately 3 hours after commencement, at the Sky Tower complex, corner Victoria and Federal Streets, Auckland. Overnight stay at hotel in Auckland.

Day 3: Auckland – Rotorua via Waitomo Caves

Drive towards Rotorua via Waitomo Caves. Arrive Rotorua and proceed to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Rotorua.

Day 4: Rotorua – Legends of Rotorua

This morning visit Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserves to see boiling mud pools roaring geysers. Visit all the attractions like the Agrodome Park. Overnight at hotel in Rotorua.

Day 5: Rotorua – Christchurch (By flight)

Check out from the hotel and drive towards Airport. Drop your rental vehicle and later board flight to Christchurch. Arrive Christchurch and pick your rental vehicle and drive towards hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Christchurch.

Day 6: Christchurch – Whale watch Kaikoura – Lake Tekapo

Today proceed for the Whale watch tour.

Board your Whale Watch Kaikoura vessel at "The Whaleway Station, Railway Station Road, Kaikoura to commence a Whale Watch Kaikoura cruise. The vessel is a modern catamaran designed especially for whale watching. The main passenger cabin is enclosed, air-conditioned and fitted with comfortable seating, while large outside decks offer great viewing and photo opportunities. Prepare for exciting up-close encounters with Giant Sperm Whales. Clients may also see migratory humpback whales (June-July), Hector's and Dusky Dolphins, Orcas (December-March) and NZ Fur Seals, as well as plenty of bird species including Royal Albatross, Petrels and Shearwaters. Cruise concludes approximately 3 hours 30 minutes after commencement, back at "The Whaleway Station. After finishing the tour drive towards lake Tekapo.

Overnight stay at hotel in Lake Tekapo.

Day 7: Lake Tekapo – Mount Cook – 20 min Glacier landing – Queenstown

Check out from the hotel and drive towards Mount Cook. Arrive Mount Cook and do the Glacier Landing. Join your crew to commence a Alpine Vista helicopter tour. Sweep through the rugged high country landscape of the Ban Ohau Mountain Range to a landing site on a snow field high in the mountains. Enjoy the fantastic vista from this alpine setting as you look out to the mountains and glaciers, and down into the valleys that were carved out by glaciers centuries ago. Tour concludes approximately 20 minutes after commencement. After finishing the tour drive towards Queenstown. Arrive Queenstown and drive towards hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Queenstown.

Day 8: Queenstown – Skyline Gondola & 1 Luge Ride

Today proceed for the Gondola & Luge Ride. Later proceed for the Shot over Jet. Overnight stay at hotel in Queenstown.

Day 9: Queenstown - Milford Sound

Follow the southern arm of Lake Wakatipu to Lumsden, and onward to Lake TeAnau. Enter the Eglinton Valley and travel through the breath taking man made Homer Tunnel to reach Milford Sound. Enjoy a cruise on this world famous fiord, dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen Falls. Return to Queenstown. Overnight at Hotel in Queenstown.

Day 10: Queenstown– Departure

Check out from the hotel and drive towards Airport. Drop your rental vehicle and later board flight to onwards destination.
