I just returned from the missionary boat trips where I was able to remain on the river with over twenty people on board. I returned to Santa Cruz to take Leisa on the last trip, but we could not make



it back on time. This was due to the unrest, plus travelling by land with uncertain and dangerous situations along the way. The best solution was for the boat trip to continue with the fifteen members on board until completed. Leisa and I plan to meet

up with them when they arrive.



Well, the Lord has done a remarkable work in the lives of many people. We were able to preach in many villages, donate Bibles, hand out booklets with the gospels, plus the book of Romans and John. Once we reached the fifth trip, we had 132 new believers registered. Praise God!



We took a number of professionals and others with us. This included doctors, dentists, dental assistants, vets, psychologists, along with those who teach children. There were others involved who wanted to serve as well like cooks, and so forth.



My brothers and sisters, Bolivia needs your prayers. We received a letter from some missionary friends working in Chapare, Bolivia. Those ministering in Chapare are suffering persecution. A few days ago, two Christian families were whipped for not getting involved in the marches/protests in La Paz. One brother was murdered for refusing to participate. Please pray for those missionaries that must endure abuse for the gospel's sake.



We would like to thank those who were willing to contribute so that this ministry could move forward. Later, we will have a complete report about what the Lord is doing. Please keep praying, we plan to finish up by mid-June.
