Historical Sights & Culture

Nafplio (The First Capital)

One of the most charming and historic cities in Greece. During your visit, make sure not to miss:

- **Palamidi & Bourtzi:** The imposing Venetian fortress of Palamidi towers over the city (accessible by car or via its famous steps), offering breathtaking views. In the middle of the harbor stands Bourtzi, the famous castle-landmark.
- **Old Town & Land Gate:** Stroll through the picturesque, cobblestone alleys of the Old Town and discover the historic Land Gate, which used to be the sole entrance to the fortified city from the mainland.
- **Historical Landmarks:** Admire the First Parliament of the Greeks (Vouleftiko), the First Military Academy, the first pharmacy of Greece, and the prominent statue of Ioannis Kapodistrias.
- **Lion of the Bavarians:** An impressive, monumental 19th-century sculpture carved directly into the natural rock face.

Ancient Theatre of Epidaurus

One of the most important and globally renowned archaeological sites. It is famous worldwide for its perfect, uncompromised acoustics and its stunning natural surroundings.

Mycenae & Ancient Tiryns

Discover the greatest monuments of the magnificent Mycenaean civilization. Marvel at the imposing **Cyclopean Walls** and the famous **Lion Gate**, which stand as eternal symbols of power.

One of the most mysterious and ancient structures in Greece, located a short distance from the historic city of Argos, continuing to intrigue researchers and visitors alike.

Day Trips & Natural Wonders

- **Porto Heli, Ermioni & Agios Aimilianos:** Beautiful cosmopolitan destinations in southern Argolis with wonderful indented coastlines, ideal for memorable day trips.
- **Spetses & Hydra:** These elegant Saronic Gulf islands are easily accessible by boat from the shores of Ermionida, offering an authentic, aristocratic summer experience with a car-free charm.
- **Devil's Bridge (Diavologefyro) in Troizina:** An impressive natural landscape featuring a lush green ravine of wild beauty, rugged rock formations, running waters, and trails immersed in nature.
- **Didima Craters:** Two unique and awe-inspiring geological formations (sinkholes) offering panoramic views, with small, picturesque chapels built inside one of the craters.
- **Franchthi Cave:** One of the most significant prehistoric caves in Europe, located near Koilada, bearing witness to human presence since the Paleolithic era.

Local Tastes & Gastronomy

Argolis is famous for its rich culinary tradition. During your stay, be sure to try:

- **Fresh Fish:** Enjoy fresh seafood right by the water at traditional seaside taverns.
- **Greek Olive Oil:** The exceptional extra virgin olive oil of the region forms the foundation of every local recipe.
- **Traditional Sweets:** Taste local almond sweets (amygdalota), traditional spoon sweets, and authentic local pies.
