Sl. No.	Event Name	How to Conduct the Event
1	Technical Essay Writing – CS Themes	Give topics like AI ethics, Big Data impact, Metaverse, Blockchain, Cloud Computing, etc. Students write structured essays.
2	Paper Presentation on CS Topics	Students select emerging CS domains (ML, NLP, IoT, Cybersecurity) and present PPTs like a mini-conference.
3	Debate on Trending CS Technologies	Conduct debates on coding vs no-code tools, AI replacing jobs, data privacy, VR in education, etc.
4	CS Elocution Competition	Students speak on women in computing, open-source culture, digital citizenship, or importance of coding literacy.
5	Tech Storytelling – Coding & AI Tales	Students narrate creative tech stories—AI gaining emotions, futuristic devices, ethical dilemmas in coding.
6	Research Paper Review – CS Special	Provide IEEE papers on ML, deep learning, cyber threats, etc. Students summarise methods & applications.
7	Documentation & Coding Report Workshop	Teach students how to write README files, GitHub documentation, project reports, and API documentation.
8	CS Vocabulary Challenge	Quiz students on CS-specific terms: recursion, compiler, API, hashing, protocol, data structures, etc.
9	Coding-Themed Spell Bee	Include CS words like algorithm, cryptography, pseudocode, stack, polymorphism, virtualization.
10	Tech Article Writing – CSE Magazine	Students write articles on coding careers, tech leaders, startup culture, or new CS trends for the college magazine.
11	CSE Open Mic – Tech Talk	Students share insights on coding journey, hackathon experiences, internships, or their mini-projects.
12	Computer Science Quiz Competition	Questions on programming languages, pioneers (Ada Lovelace, Grace Hopper), databases, OS, algorithms, etc.
13	Script Writing for Tech Skits	Students prepare humorous or educational scripts on debugging life, coding errors, tech support memes, etc.
14	CS Caption Writing Contest	Show images of code, servers, robots, bugs, UI/UX screens and ask students to create witty/creative captions.
15	Panel Discussion on CS Careers	Students discuss AI vs Data Science career paths, cybersecurity jobs, cloud roles, women in tech leadership.
16	Dialogue Writing – Tech Conversations	Students write dialogues between a programmer & compiler, user & AI bot, hacker & analyst, etc.
17	Monthly CSE Newsletter	Create a department newsletter with coding tips, tech news, student projects, GitHub highlights.
18	Mock Technical Interview (CSE)	Conduct mock interviews on DSA, OOP, DBMS, OS concepts with focus on verbal clarity and explanation skills.
19	Mini CS Literary Fest	A themed event with AI-poetry, coding stories, poster presentations, and quick technical speaking events.
20	Kannada CS Literature Appreciation	Explore Kannada authors who write about technology; students read, discuss, or summarise tech-based Kannada articles.
