Question 1: What is one kind thing I can do for someone in my home today?


Simple Action: Offer help without being asked—tidy a small space, share a toy, give a hug, or say something kind.

Simple Action: Pause, take three slow breaths, and choose one calm word or action before responding.

Question 3: How can my words or actions help make our home feel safe and loving?

Simple Action: Use gentle words, listen without interrupting, or thank someone for something they did.
