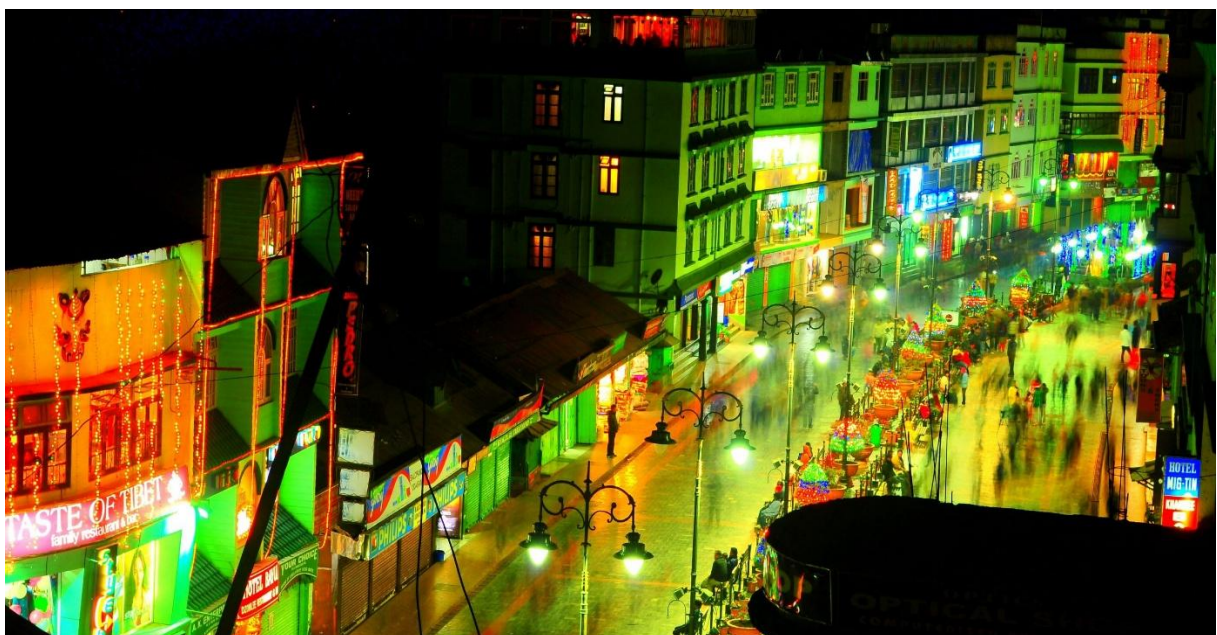


## DAY 1 – ARRIVAL IN GANGTOK: WHERE THE MOUNTAINS BEGIN TO WHISPER

Later, visit the peaceful Enchi Monastery, surrounded by tall pines and mountain breezes. With its sacred chants, religious murals, and spiritual energy, this monastery brings calmness to the heart and soul.

Evening in Gangtok is perfect for a relaxed walk, shopping for souvenirs, or trying out delicious local dishes.



## **DAY 5 – TSOMGO LAKE, NATHULA PASS & BABA MANDIR: THE ICONIC HIGH-ALTITUDE MARVELS OF SIKKIM**

At 12,400 ft, the journey to Tsomgo Lake is a breathtaking one — steep climbs, misty forests, and panoramic mountain views accompany you all the way. Tsomgo Lake itself is a natural masterpiece. A glacial lake nestled amidst towering peaks, its color changes with seasons — emerald green in summer, deep blue in spring, and mirror-like during winter when it freezes completely. Yaks dressed in traditional decorations add a touch of charm to the landscape.

Next, visit the legendary Baba Harbhajan Singh Temple, built in honor of the soldier whose spirit is believed to protect the region. The temple holds fascinating stories, rituals, and deep emotional significance for the locals and the Indian Army.

From here, you'll travel to the iconic Nathula Pass, which is INCLUDED in your Tripino package. Standing tall at 14,140 ft on the historic Indo-China border, Nathula offers an exhilarating high-altitude experience — icy winds, snow walls, army bunkers, and stunning panoramas make it a highlight of the entire Sikkim journey. Being a part of the ancient Silk Route, Nathula Pass carries centuries of history and remains one of the most awe-inspiring places to visit in the Eastern Himalayas.
