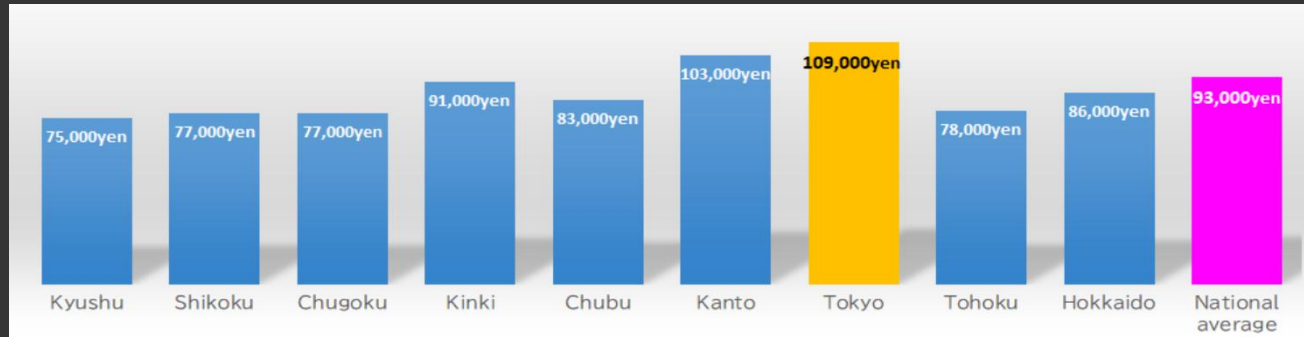

- Cost of living: ¥60,000~¥80,000 (₱27,000~₱36,500)



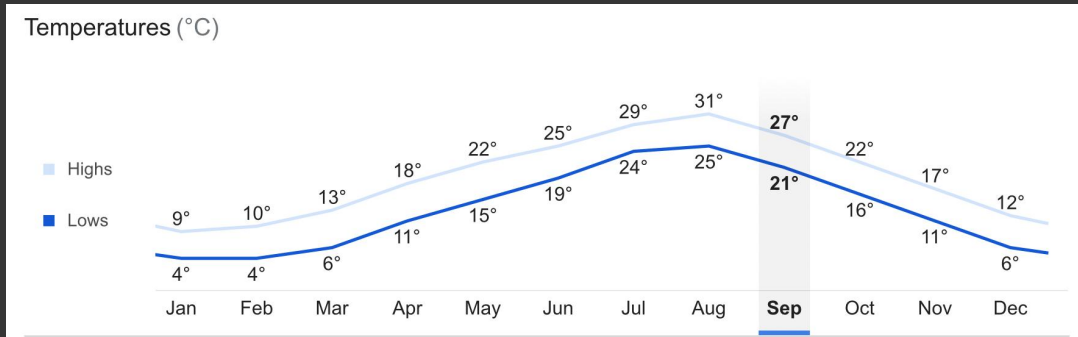
