**Preamble:**

The urgent conditions experienced by the people of the world in general, including conflicts, wars, displacement, and racial discrimination in all its forms based on appearance, color, race, and belief, as well as conflicts founded on domination, control, and influence, the absence of social justice among members of the same society, and the decline in the level of services and rights due to various groups of human beings who have found themselves suffering from disability or deficiency in one aspect of their lives, all of which should fundamentally be the responsibility of states and governments to fulfill toward these groups through education, care, support, and facilitation of their lives, including the provision of suitable work according to their circumstances, have all become threatened with complete absence as a result of neglect and/or preoccupation with other matters.

In view of the absence of justice, and indeed the disruption of the judicial system in many cases in favor of the controlling parties and those with influence and power, this has caused crime to spread widely and noticeably in societies. Within this context, the perception of the judicial authority has shifted from being a body to which people turn to recover their rights and achieve their interests into one that wastes those rights and even seizes them.

The absence of an elevated human conscience has its reasons in this era. When noble values and the sense of civic responsibility decline among those who hold influence—and what is meant here is not only those who possess governmental authority, but also those who possess civil authority, whether material or moral, among those who have the qualities of a conscious and noble human being who does not accept injustice and does not tolerate violations of human rights in all areas of life, including food, drink, shelter, treatment, education, culture, and a legal system possessing prompt justice that safeguards rights, life, property, and freedom of expression, and rights in general on the basis of justice among members of societies—then it has become necessary for us to rise in order to establish this humanitarian entity that will preserve and protect human rights, monitor and follow up on all forms of assault and abuse against human beings without discrimination and in all fields, while at the same time extending help and assistance to all who need it in every condition and circumstance, whether caused by wars, displacement, or natural disasters, and striving through the establishment of humanitarian units that believe in humanitarian work according to need and necessity in health, education, relief work, spreading awareness of the democratic approach, and preserving and protecting freedoms in general.

## **Objectives of the Organization:**

The absence of social justice and the spread of ethnic and sectarian conflicts on the basis of belief and/or group, origin, and sect have led to the loss of much confidence in the objectives of international organizations working in the field of human rights, relief, and human development, as their work has become directed toward specific groups and for specific purposes and no longer views the human being as a dignified human created by his Creator without discrimination. Therefore, our organization has set its lofty goals to serve human beings without regard to name, affiliation, belief, or origin, but solely on the basis that a human is a human, as follows:

1. To provide humanitarian relief work, including food, drink, and shelter, in cases of wars, conflicts, and natural disasters at the place where they occur.
2. To carry out monitoring of human rights and public freedoms, follow up on cases that constitute violations of human rights, form the necessary legal teams to fulfill their duties toward oppressed groups, issue annual or periodic reports on the status of these rights to the relevant and competent authorities, and undertake all actions that would lift injustice and oppression from them.

3. To carry out the required humanitarian role in following up on cases of forcibly disappeared persons, missing persons, and prisoners for reasons based on political position or due to intellectual, religious, or doctrinal belief, by adopting their cases through all available legal means.

For this purpose, the organization adopts every complaint submitted to it that involves multiple cases and not merely individual ones in this field, such that it compiles sufficient information through an information bank regarding these cases, lists the names and all related data, publishes and follows them up, provides the necessary reports in that regard, and also follows up with the families of the missing under this heading.

### Freedoms and the Promotion of Democracy:

The organization works to spread awareness regarding freedoms and human rights and belief in democracy based on justice and the right of all to live with dignity and preserve their fundamental rights. Accordingly, it shall undertake the following:

1. To promote the democratic approach through organizing courses, seminars, and purposeful conferences and working to shape their aims and objectives by raising awareness among societies of the necessity of preserving and caring for them.
2. To form specialized committees to monitor elections of all kinds in order to follow up on any violations of the democratic approach in accordance with the applicable international standards and values.

3. To establish media stations and channels to spread democratic thought and approach, preserve public freedoms, and follow up on issues related to relevant societies.

4. To establish institutes and/or universities based on standards of values and noble ethics without regard to material profit, in a way that ensures the building of a conscious human being who believes in the right of the human being and the protection of his freedoms.

5. To hold training and qualification courses for youth in order to engage in thought based on respect for law and order and to reinforce the concept of respect for the human being.

## Article (1): Definitions

- The Organization: The Human Rights, Peace, and International Law Organization (US&UN).
- The President: The President of the Organization.
- Board of Directors: The members who are elected and/or appointed to manage the Organization and make decisions.
- Chairman of the Board of Directors: The President of the Organization.
- Members of the Court: Every member affiliated with the Organization who fulfills the membership conditions and complies with its terms and annual requirements.
- Observer: The registered member in the Organization who has been appointed for this purpose as a friendly observer.
- Advisor: The registered member in the Organization who has been appointed as an advisor for the purpose of carrying out specific tasks.
- Headquarters: The main headquarters of the Organization.
- Organization Offices: Those branches established in countries and international communities for the purpose of carrying out the humanitarian and monitoring functions and duties of the Organization around the world.
- Investment Activities and Operations: Those projects and structures carried out and established by the Organization for non-profit purposes, with the aim of supporting the Organization's funds so it can perform its humanitarian duties and functions in the fields of health, education, media, development, and investment.

## Article (2): Purposes and Objectives of the Organization

1. To carry out relief work and extend help and assistance to those in need.
2. To provide health services and family care.
3. To monitor human rights and lift injustice and oppression.
4. To protect the rights of minorities and ethnic groups.
5. To protect and preserve democracy and freedom of opinion, expression, belief, and thought.
6. To protect childhood and the family in a manner consistent with the Geneva Convention.
7. To provide the necessary services for persons with special needs and to preserve and care for their fundamental rights in accordance with international law.
8. To monitor and follow up on the cases of missing persons, forcibly disappeared persons, and prisoners in general in matters related to political position or opinion, or due to religion, sect, or sectarianism.
9. To monitor elections at all levels and of all types, issue reports, and submit them to the concerned authorities and public opinion.
10. To inspect places of detention, prisons, and detention centers and follow up on the issues of prisoners.

11. To advocate for just humanitarian causes around the world.

12. To spread awareness, knowledge, and culture and reinforce the approach of education and higher education.

13. To spread the culture of peace, international security, and social and international reconciliation.

14. Not to interfere in the policies of states and to limit activity to fields related to humanitarian affairs and the protection and preservation of human beings.

Article (3):

Regional offices shall be established in countries related to humanitarian work according to circumstances, and a director for the branches shall be appointed by decision of the Board of Directors for a limited period and with defined powers.

Article (4):

The President chairs the Board of Directors in its sessions, and decisions are taken by the casting vote of the President.

Article (5):

Members of the Board of Directors of the Organization shall be appointed and/or elected according to the most suitable circumstances for the purpose of facilitating the mission of the Organization.

Article (6):

A fund for the Organization shall be established, and a bank account and/or bank accounts shall be opened as needed and according to the circumstances in the country of headquarters and/or any other country according to possibilities and need.

Article (7):

The Organization shall have the right to invest in the fields of health through the establishment of hospital projects, health centers, and non-profit clinics to serve humanity and support the Organization's fund so that it may carry out its humanitarian duties and activities in any country as needed.

Article (8):

The Organization shall have the right to invest in the fields of education and higher education, as needed, by opening schools, institutes, and universities to spread knowledge and learning and to confront the control of capital over this sector on a non-profit basis, thereby opening the door of education to the less fortunate groups.

Article (9):

The Organization shall have the right to invest in fields of development and qualification and in any investment field that would support the Organization's funds so that it may carry out its great humanitarian duties.

Article (10):

The Organization shall have the right to establish media units and satellite channels to spread democratic thought and awareness and combat corruption and terrorism.

Article (11):

An international institute shall be established for the purpose of qualifying relevant personalities through training and preparation in leadership and the drawing of high-level policies for societies and states, as a higher diplomatic institute.

Article (12):

To work toward establishing an international journal for publishing human rights reports around the world so that it may serve as a beacon for evaluating the condition of states and their policies toward human rights, such that these reports become a documented reference.

Article (13):

To form fact-finding committees of influential international personalities to investigate abuses and violations of human rights in cases of conflicts and wars and in cases where some states are in clear violation and breach of human rights.

Article (14):

To form committees of distinguished and prominent personalities to work as an intervention team to resolve disputes and settle conflicts between states and to establish peace and security under the title of the Committee of the Wise.

Article (15):

The Organization shall have the right to appoint auditors, legal researchers, and advisors in all fields of the Organization's work under the title of volunteer, and this does not prevent the payment of compensation for services and expenses for this purpose.

Article (16):

All activities, work, and investments of the Organization shall be considered non-profit and are not intended for profit, and its funds shall be regarded as intended for spending on humanitarian projects, with the aim of sustaining humanitarian work.

Article (17):

Spreading awareness among members of societies is a fundamental pillar of the Organization's work, and for this purpose it has the right to hold international conferences through which annual reports are presented and international personalities working for human rights are honored.

Article (18):

For the purpose of documenting the Organization's work and activities, an information bank and a website shall be established through which all events and activities are published and documented, and related bulletins and news are issued.

Article (19):

Every person of good conduct and behavior shall have the right to join this Organization as a member according to the conditions established for that purpose, and membership shall be withdrawn in the event of violation of public order and/or violation of the principles and objectives of the Organization's work.

Article (20):

Neither the Organization nor its individuals and members may violate the laws of the states in which the member is present, and all members, under any title, must respect the laws and regulations of the states, under penalty of cancellation of membership.

Article (21):

A court shall be established within the Organization whose purposes and objectives are to consider complaints submitted by individuals, states, and societies concerning human rights violations, and on the basis of supporting documents the appropriate measure shall be taken, either by dismissing the matter for lack of sufficient evidence or by proceeding with it and referring it to the competent local or international authorities.

Article (22):

For the purpose of enabling the Organization's special court to carry out its duties and functions, specialized judges shall be appointed according to the type of complaint, and a president for this court shall be appointed, with its seat being at the main headquarters of the Organization.

Article (23):

In conducting the Organization's work, priority shall be given to humanitarian work in the countries most in need of humanitarian services and projects, according to the assessment of the Organization's Board of Directors.

Article (24):

The Organization shall have the right to receive aid and financial support from clear and identified parties whose sources are lawful, in order to help deliver it to the most affected and needy parties.

Article (25):

Neither the Organization nor its administration may receive any material or moral support or any kind of assistance from suspicious and/or unlawful parties and/or those having objectives outside the humanitarian objectives of the Organization.

Article (26):

The Board of Directors of the Organization shall consist of a number of members not fewer than three persons, who shall be elected and/or appointed by the President of the Organization according to what is deemed most suitable.

Article (27):

The President of the Organization is the Chairman of its Board of Directors and its Chief Executive. For this purpose, Professor Riyadh Saddam Hasan shall be the President, as he has provided all material and moral support for the establishment of this institution at his own expense, out of his belief in the importance of humanitarian work and the necessity of preserving human dignity. Therefore, it is agreed that Mr. Professor Riyadh Saddam shall be appointed President for life, and he shall have the right to delegate whomever he wishes to represent him in any international forum or humanitarian missions.

Article (28):

The human right to a dignified life for every person is protected, and it is a noble and sacred right.

Article (29):

Neither the Organization nor any member thereof shall have the right to participate and/or contribute to any conflict and/or battles or disputes between states and individuals.

Article (30):

The Lord God, the Creator of all Humans, and all Humans are equal in rights and duties, and standing by the oppressed is a divine message that must be carried out.

Article (31):

The main headquarters of the Organization shall be in the United States of America, and it shall have the right to open offices throughout the world affiliated with the center.

Article (32):

The Organization shall have its own law regulating the relationship between its individuals and members and the responsibilities of managers and heads of offices, and this law shall not contradict the law of the state of headquarters (the center) for the purpose of regulating relationships, memberships, and responsibilities.

Article (33):

Every individual, male or female, regardless of religion, belief, sect, color, thought, or opinion, who believes in humanitarian work as an umbrella and urgent necessity, deserves membership in the Organization.
