

Bible Reading Plans by Level (OT + NT Balanced)

1) Beginner Plan — 24 Months (2 Chapters per Day, 2 Watches)

Day	1st Watch (Morning) — OT	2nd Watch (Evening) — NT
1	Genesis 1	Matthew 1
2	Genesis 2	Matthew 2
3	Genesis 3	Matthew 3
4	Genesis 4	Matthew 4
5	Genesis 5	Matthew 5

Pattern: Continue reading sequentially through the Old Testament in the morning and the New Testament in the evening. At 2 chapters per day, the full Bible is completed in approximately 24 months.

2) Intermediate Plan — 12 Months (3–4 Chapters per Day, 3 Watches)

Day	1st Watch (Morning) — OT	2nd Watch (Noon) — NT	3rd Watch (Evening) — NT/OT
1	Genesis 1–2	Matthew 1	Matthew 2
2	Genesis 3–4	Matthew 3	Matthew 4
3	Genesis 5–6	Matthew 5	Matthew 6
4	Genesis 7–8	Matthew 7	Matthew 8

Pattern: Read 2 OT chapters in the morning, 1 NT chapter at noon, and 1 NT chapter in the evening. Some days may include 3 chapters instead of 4 for flexibility. At 3-4 chapters per day, the full Bible is completed in approximately 12 months.

3) Advanced Plan — 6 Months (5–6 Chapters per Day, 3 Watches)

Day	1st Watch (Morning)	2nd Watch (Afternoon)	3rd Watch (Evening)
1	Genesis 1–3	Matthew 1–2	Genesis 4
2	Genesis 5–6	Matthew 3–4	Genesis 7
3	Genesis 8–10	Matthew 5–6	Genesis 11

Pattern: Mix Old and New Testament readings daily. Average 5–6 chapters per day divided across three watches. Continue sequentially through both Testaments. At 5-6 chapters per day, the full Bible is completed in approximately 6 months.

4) High-Advanced Plan — Intensive (4 Watches: Every 6 Hours)

Day	1st Watch (Morning)	2nd Watch (Afternoon)	3rd Watch (Evening)	4th Watch (Night)
1	Genesis 1–2	Genesis 3–4	Matthew 1–2	Matthew 3–4
2	Genesis 5–6	Genesis 7–8	Matthew 5–6	Matthew 7–8
3	Genesis 9–10	Genesis 11–12	Matthew 9–10	Matthew 11– 12

Pattern: Four daily reading times (6/6/6/6 hours). Designed for intensive discipleship, Bible school, or revival seasons. Average 7–8 chapters per day. At 8 chapters per day, the full Bible is completed in approximately 3 months.
