The Elder Woods (Lore)

There is a vast, ancient forest where the wind speaks in whispers and the trees remember songs from ages past.

This is the Elder Woods, a living boundary between two worlds.

To the west, the Elven realms thrive in deep harmony with nature. Here, the Lórenvalë, or “Songs Beyond the Elder Woods”, echo through sacred groves and silver-lit clearings. Elven priestesses sing spells of healing, guardians patrol moss-covered paths, and sacred rites are performed to preserve what remains of their once-boundless domain.

To the east lie the Ashlands, scorched lands once torn apart by fire and forgotten wrath. There, humans endure under red skies, led by the Dawn Mothers and their rites of renewal. Though resilient, mankind bears the scars of an age-old cataclysm that burned deep into the earth, and into memory.

Between them, the Elder Woods stand scarred but unyielding. Charred in places, yet rooted in strength. Neither elven nor human territory, this forest is watched over by the Guardians of the Trees, who weave melodies not to forget what was lost, but to nurture what remains.

There is no war between elf and man, only distance, upheld by tradition, fear, and reverence. Trade is rare, parley even rarer. But the threads of fate weave strangely, and the songs sung beneath the canopies often carry farther than expected.

This album is a journey through that world. Not told through dialogue or narration, but through music, memory, and myth. Each track captures a moment, a ritual, or a passage through the heart of a living world on the edge of remembrance and renewal.


Close your eyes, and walk the forest eastward.


Lórenvalë — Songs Beyond the Elder Woods

All vocal tracks are sung in Quenya, the ancient language of the Elves, and accompanied by English translations, presented alongside the original text for clarity and context. Instrumental tracks contain no lyrics.

These songs were written not just as melodies, but as spells, memories, and laments, carried on the wind beneath the canopy of the Elder Woods. Some evoke ancient rituals, others moments of quiet sorrow or distant hope.

Where no lyrics exist, the music itself tells the story.

Note: Minor lyrical variations may occur between this booklet and the vocal recordings, due to melodic phrasing and artistic interpretation.


