TRANSITIONS (changes in tempo, key signature, and directions such as D.C., D.S., Coda or repeat signs)

RHYTHMIC ACCURACY (consistency of tempo and meter and precision of rhythmic patterns)

3. \_\_\_\_ Articulation (tonguing and slurring, attack/release of notes )
4. \_\_\_\_ Centered Tone Quality
5. \_\_\_\_ Entrances and releases
6. \_\_\_\_ Intonation (matching pitch and playing in tune)
