

Student Code of Conduct

This Student Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behaviour and responsibilities to ensure mutual respect, academic integrity, and a productive learning atmosphere. By enrolling in Lighthouse Academy's programmes, students agree to abide by this Code of Conduct.

1. General Expectations All students are expected to:

- Refrain from using inappropriate language, gestures, or materials during classes or activities.
- Follow instructions provided by instructors or programme leaders promptly and respectfully.
- Maintain a safe and conducive learning environment by refraining from disruptive behaviour.



4. Attendance and Participation Students are expected to:

- Attend all scheduled lessons and activities punctually.
- Inform instructors in advance of any absences, tardiness, or inability to participate.
- Stay engaged and complete assigned tasks and homework on time.
