CEREBOLICE STORE S aly Socraflix is a hybrid between an educational consultancy and a digital learning service. **Essentially, I work with your** team to create stunning videos for you to take, keep and use as many times as you need.

You decide how to use my service. It could be for a tenpart series on a difficult GCSE Paper, or a single video for a whole-school assembly. It could plug gaps in an otherwise strong curriculum or it could provide the foundation for an entirely new scheme of work. It could address an important but difficult safeguarding topic, or it could celebrate an annual festival.

We work together to decide on an appropriate style, tone and aesthetic for the project, which is then appropriately pitched to your target students. The videos can come with additional resources, such as worksheets and assessments. I could also provide staff training on how to implement the videos in a scheme of work, or I could help you to launch it with your school community.

Each video comes as an MP4 file with guidance on storage and shareability. The videos use a combination of traditional MS and video-editing software and AI-powered tools. This includes AI generated images and voice-overs to create a stunning and professional look. However, if you would prefer to use local voice actors and graphic designers, we can do this.

<u>services</u>

I am now ready to pilot Socraflix in a secondary school in Teesside or the surrounding area.

Together, we will create a video or series of videos that you can launch across a department or school community. I will ask for a financial contribution to the pilot, which will vary according to the scale of the project and school budget and will ask your staff to participate in feedback at the end. You decide the focus for the pilot, but see below a few examples:

Curriculum Development: Working alongside a Head of Department or specialist to create or re-design a scheme of work, supported by a series of videos

PSHE Development: Working alongside your PSHE lead to design a video or series of videos that tackles a difficult modern-day problem.

School Assemblies: Working alongside Pastoral Leads and Heads of Year to create a video, or series, that supports your school's ethos & values


Local heritage, landscape or

School leaders

I'm Laura, the founder & creator of Socraflix.



I have a passion for curriculum development and delivery. I have served as a Head of Department for eight years, achieving strong results year on year, and I have mentored several student teachers. Here is a sample of videos that I have created for the purpose of this pilot launch. Please note, they were not made following consultation with a specialist.



Explain a difficult concept: The Wall Street Crash

This is one of the hardest topics on the GCSE History curriculum. Worse, it isn't directly relevant, but students do need to understand it for their study of the Great Depression and the rise of Hitler. I would have loved to have had this video early on in my career!

Mini-series on exam skills: Macbeth

This is a mini-series of three videos that talks through the process of answering an exam question. The way I present this video is my tried and tested method for delivering lessons on exam technique.






Local landmarks & case studies: Scarborough's North Bay

I have taught GCSE Geography and it sometimes feels like an endless list of case studies! This video shows how I can use your local landmarks to create simple but engaging videos, using footage filmed on my phone.

Telling a good story: Elizabeth I's early years

The Tudors is my specialism, and while developing Socraflix, I created around 50 videos for my A Level students, covering the full exam specification. This is the last video I made for the series, and it showcases my passion for my favourite historical figure.
