## **Hangar Removal Plans**

North Las Vegas Airport (KVGT) has plans to remove some smaller hangars once their leases expire, in part to facilitate runway expansion projects. However, the airport is aware of the potential for reduced hangar space and is considering new options, as there is a waiting list for more than 100 aircraft owners. The airport is owned and operated by the Clark County Department of Aviation. [1, 2, 3]
