The CACPC leads and operates a unique Crime Prevention Hub with guidance from our active volunteer Board of Central Alberta community members.

As a non-profit, registered charity our organization works with residents to be pro-active in crime prevention. Partnering with other agencies, law enforcement and volunteers, the CACPC staff assist those who may be impacted by or are targets of property crime or fraud & scams.

The CACPC implements programs & services that include education opportunities and crime reduction initiatives.

A diverse funding model is used that includes fundraising events, grants, sponsorship & donations, "fees for service" such as CPTED reviews & assessments, CPTED training courses, as well as the sale of crime prevention merchandise like graffiti removal products, personal alarms, bike shields and microdot property kits.
