

THE GREATER DOWNTOWN VANDALISM RECOVERY GRANT

Has your downtown business or organization been impacted by vandalism? You may be eligible to offset recovery costs through the Greater Downtown Vandalism Recovery Grant.

The Greater Downtown Vandalism Recovery Grant is intended to provide economic relief to businesses and non-profit organizations in Downtown Red Deer that have been negatively impacted by vandalism.

The grant, administered by the Central Alberta Crime Prevention Centre (CACPC) and funded through the City of Red Deer, provides a 50% reimbursement (up to a maximum of \$2,000) to help cover costs incurred by vandalism repair, graffiti removal, and insurance deductibles.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for the grant, the incident must have occurred between June 1 - December 31, 2024, and a business or non-profit must:

- Be located in the Greater Downtown boundary
- Be in good standing with the City of Red Deer
- Open a file with the RCMP
- Provide proof of damage with receipts for associated costs

WHAT IS THE GREATER DOWNTOWN DISTRICT?

The Greater Downtown District includes Historic Downtown, Capstone, the Railyards, and the Business Improvement Area (BIA).



HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply for the grant, a completed Application Form must be submitted to the Central Alberta Crime Prevention Centre.

Once the repairs are complete, submit before & after pictures as well as receipts or service invoices.
