ORDINANCE NO. 2026-07

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE ZONING CODE TO ESTABLISH RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT FEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

RESOLUTION No. 2026-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF VILLAGE CAPITAL FUNDS IN A MONEY MARKET ACCOUNT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Councilman Giese made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Chambers to suspend reading of Resolution 2026-14. Roll Call Vote: All Yes. Chair declared motion carried

Carol Gissingner – account is not established yet, keeping it at Park National. This is for Capitol Fund Projects.

- Lewie Miller – Sewer Project at least 2 outside of village and 1 water. What is the situation with this and why can't we get 2675 Mounts Rd sewer hooked up.
Mayor Barnes states that we need to follow the ordinance.
David Ball stated that the property owner never submitted an application – Attorney for property owner never submitted it.
Councilman Lower stated that Schafer sat on the survey due to never getting paid. Survey needs to be completed and submitted as part of annexation, if it is not completed then there is nothing we can do.
Mayor Barnes stated that if we receive an application for annexation then council can review and make a decision.


