

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF SHAUN WATSON AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in the Village of Alexandria Police Department for a part-time Police Officer: and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the Village of Alexandria wish to fill the part-time Police Officer position; and,

WHEREAS, SHAUN WATSON began serving as a Police Officer in the Alexandria Police Department on MARCH 26, 2024 and has the necessary qualifications to fill this position: and.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 737.16 Ohio Revised Code, the Mayor appointed SHAUN WATSON as a part-time Police Officer for the Village of Alexandria to begin on APRIL 2, 2024, and Council for the Village of Alexandria now wishes to confirm this appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 737.16, Ohio Revised Code, Council for the Village of Alexandria hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of SHAUN WATSON as a part-time Police Officer beginning APRIL 2, 2024.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 737.16, Ohio Revised Code, this appointment and confirmation shall be for a probationary period of six months consecutive service (OCTOBER 2, 2024) and shall not be finally made until SHAUN WATSON has satisfactorily served the probationary period and the Mayor, with the concurrence of Council, have finally appointed SHAUN WATSON.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are consistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and specifically so that the above named Officer may immediately begin serving to his full capacity. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in the force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

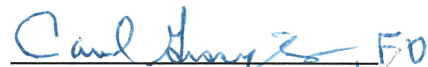
