RESOLUTION NUMBER R-2024 - 16

AN RESOLUTION AMENDING CERTAIN RULES OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 731.45 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Council of an Ohio Village shall determine its own rules; and

WHEREAS, at its January 2, 2024, organizational meeting, the Council of the Village of Alexandria adopted rules of order; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Alexandria has determined that it is desirable and necessary to now amend Rule 4, REGULAR MEETINGS;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

SECTION 1: TITLE

It is necessary to amend Rule 4, REGULAR MEETINGS, which is one of the rules for the government of the Council of the Village of Alexandria, Ohio, known as "The Rules of Procedure of the Council of the Village of Alexandria."

SECTION 2: COUNCIL RULES

The following is hereby adopted and enacted as amended as Rule 4 of The Rules of Procedure of Council of the Village of Alexandria:

RULE 4 – REGULAR MEETINGS

Regular meetings of the Council shall be held at the Council Chambers at the Alexandria Village Building, 4 West Main Street, Alexandria, Licking County, Ohio 43001, on the first (1st) and third (3rd) Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm and such other times or places as may be ordered by Council. When a regular meeting falls on a legal holiday, then the meeting shall be held on the immediately following Thursday of that week at 7:00 pm or such other time as Council may determine. Notice of all regular and special meetings will be posted on the Village website and at three (3) locations in the Village, specifically the Alexandria Public Library, the front door of the Village office, and the Alexandria Post Office, at least twenty-four (24) hours preceding the meeting.

The first (1st) meeting of the month shall be considered a routine council meeting and shall follow the established agenda. This shall give Council an


opportunity to get up to speed with the daily activities occurring within the village. Village Officials will be expected to provide updates during this meeting. The second (2nd) meeting of the month shall follow an agenda, however this meeting will serve as a time slot to conduct committee meetings. Legislation may be voted on by council during if it has been discussed in a previous council meeting.

Section 3: All prior ordinances and resolutions or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, including codified ordinances, are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part or parts thereof and the remainder of said ordinance, ordinances, resolution or resolutions not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: In accordance with ORC Section 731.30, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Alexandria, and shall go into full force and effect immediately upon passage by the council of the Village of Alexandria.
