

Resolution No. R2024-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A FUNDING APPLICATION THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) ADMINISTERED BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Alexandria wishes to construct sidewalk improvements along several streets within the village as there is a definite need to address public safety; and

WHEREAS, ODOT provides funds to local governments through the Transportation Alternatives Program to enhance public safety and provide pedestrian and recreational trail facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Alexandria is working to secure design funding for this project and is also seeking construction funds; and

WHEREAS, the TAP program currently funds pedestrian project construction costs with 80% TAP funds and 20% Federal Safety Funding. The TAP program currently funds planning and design costs with 80% TAP funds and 20% local match. Right of way acquisition is 100% funded by the Village of Alexandria (if needed); and

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Alexandria, County of Licking, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit the ODOT TAP funding application.

SECTION 2. Upon award, the funds will be used to construct sidewalks along various streets within the village including Main, Kerr, Liberty, Mill, and Granville.

SECTION 3. The construction cost of the project is estimated to be \$1,430,900.00, planned to be funded with TAP funds and Federal Safety funds. The Village of Alexandria agrees to pay 100% of the construction cost over and above the maximum amount provided by ODOT and for all costs associated with right of way activities (if needed). The design and planning cost of the project is estimated to be \$250,000.00, planned to be funded with 80% TAP funds in the amount of \$200,000.00 and 20% local match in the amount of \$50,000.00. The Village of Alexandria agrees to pay the 20% local match portion of the design and planning phase.

SECTION 4. If the application is approved for ODOT TAP funding, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above-described project.
